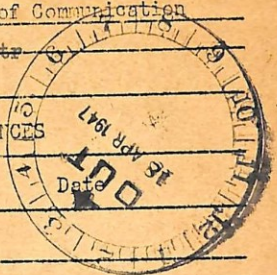

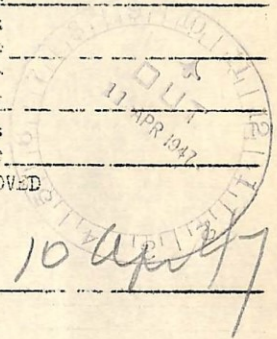

A special press release from Public Relations Office, AFMSPAC, dated 1 February 1946, stated that no applications for recognition of guerrilla units will be accepted by this headquarters after 15 March 1946. The recent press release from Public Relations Office, PHILRYCOM, further announced the closing date, 15 March 1947, for the submission of applications for individual non-casualty recognition.

Your request for recognition of the Fighting Bolo Battalion of Madalum, Lanao, was received at this headquarters 8 March 1947 and does not meet the unit deadline referred to in paragraph 2, above.

It is considered generally that all concerned had ample opportunity to prepare unit applications for recognition by 15 March 1946. In the opinion of this headquarters, your request for an extension of the time limit mentioned above is not adequately justified and, therefore, is not favorably considered.

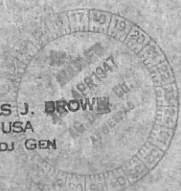
Returned herewith is the submitted roster in duplicate.

I have the honor to submit herewith the list of names of these Fighting Bolo Battalion of Madalum Ianao.

These persons appears on this list are all issued Identification Card, by Lt. Mohamad-Ali Demaporo and Lt. Pamarinta Iao, signed by Captain Manuel F. Cabal authorized by General Fort and were all accepted for service *last March* 15, 1942.

These organization was one of those assigned to Barorao Malabang and Karokotan and they first persons who was always attacking the Japs in Ganassi, and Malabang during the supermacy period of the Imperial Japanes forces in Ianao on 1942. And when the Japanes notice that Gadungan has the Headqurter of the Bolo Batallion they surprisedly attacked Gadungann Municipal District of Madalum, Ianao and fight with the Bolo Batallion and burned the headqurter of this organization and all houses in Gadungan were also burned by the Japs.

These persons wish to learn from this office about their service, wether they will be paid or not, as they are supose to gave their life for one minnute during the supermacy period of the Imperial Japanes in Ianao on 1942.

I hope that this office will help these persons who was supose to gave their life for one minnute in defending our country and becoming very poor during the surprised attacked of ~~GADUNGAN~~ the Imperial Japanes in Gadungan, Madalum Ianao.
