Special press release from Public Relations Office, APWESPM, dated 1 February 1946, stated that no applications for recognition of guerrilla units will be accepted by this headquarters after 15 March 1946.

Your request for recognition of Balo Battalion Unit was received at this headquarters 5 April 1946 in envelope postmarked April 2, 1946 and does not meet deadline referred to in paragraph 2, above.

It is considered generally that all concerned have had ample opportunity to prepare applications for recognition. In the opinion of this headquarters, your request for an extension of the time limit mentioned above is not adequately justified and therefore is not favorably considered.

Subject : History of the Singeara, Lumbutan, BOLO BATTALION UNIT,
 To: Commanding General AFWESPAC Ape 707
 Thru PA. HQ. Manila, Ape 501

1. The following brief history and activities of the Boile Battalion Unit, 81st. Division USAFFE of Singeara, Lumbutan, Lanac, is hereby submitted together with attached roster of troops for consideration.

2. The Boile Battalion Unit, of Singeara, Lumbutan, was organized and swurred to in accordance with Mokammedan taking oath by Mamarinta Lao, now a Captain in the PA. and a former Organizer of the Boile Battalion, in the Province of Lanac, to the service of the 81st. Division USAFFE, Lanac, Military Sector, with the consent of General William Sharp, commanding General of Visayas-Mindanao Forces USAFFE on or about the part February 1942. The Boile Battalion were organized with the primary missions as follows :

1. To support the Infantry unit, during actual combat.
2. Guarding the Malabang beach in order to give timely warning to the USAFFE Force in case of enemy landing.
3. To act as labor Battalion.
4. To guard bridges, roads and checked fifth columnist activities.
5. To serve as a combat Unit ambassh purposes.

3. Aside of the above-mentioned missions the different Companies in said organization had performed the following activities from the actual landing on or about April 1942, to the date of general surrender on May 27, 1942:

1. Evacuation of the Philippine Army soldiers family at Lumbutan to Tambacan, an evacuation place prepared by Captain Mamarinta Lao, at Macadar.
2. Evacuation of wounded and retreating soldiers from the front line at Malabang and Ganassi to the Division Hospital at Bebong, Romain, Lanac.
3. Acted as guide to all retreating force to the assembly area at Bebong, Romain, Lanac.
4. Aside of the already mentioned activities of the Organization, again the Boile Battalion of this Unit, had performed an engagement with the enemy after the general surrender on May 27, 1942, as follows:
 1. Attacked the Japanese Garrison at Ganassi under Major Manalao Mindalane.
 2. Had participated in the annihilation of the Japanese patrol at Tamparan, Lanac.
 3. Attacked the Japanese Garrison at Malabang, Lanac.

It is to be stated in this connection that during the induction of Maranao leaders by Capt. Mamarinta Lao, he told the people that they will be entitled to all pay and allowances equivalent to that of regular soldier for actual services rendered.

Request therefore that due consideration be given in the interest of these people who willingly sacrificed themselves in obedience to order and instructions .
