Dear Mr. Caidic:

This will acknowledge receipt on 19 March 1947 of two letters each dated 11 March 1947, in which you forward rosters of the members of the Volunteer Guard Unit (Regiment) attached to the Leyte Guerrilla Forces of Colonel Ruperto K. Kangleon in Leyte, Philippines.

Special press release from Public Relations Office, AFWESPAC, dated 1 February 1946, stated that no applications for recognition of guerrilla units would be accepted by this headquarters after 15 March 1946. Your request for recognition of the Volunteer Guard Unit (Regiment) was received at this headquarters on 19 March 1947 in your letter dated 11 March 1947, and does not meet the deadline referred to above. The recent press release from Public Relations Office, PHILRYCOM, announced the closing date, 15 March 1947, for the submission of individual non-casualty applications for recognition.

It is generally considered that all concerned have had ample opportunity to prepare unit applications for recognition. In the opinion of this headquarters, your request for an extension of the time limit mentioned above is not adequately justified and therefore, is not favorably considered.

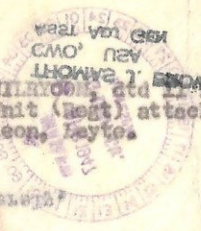


