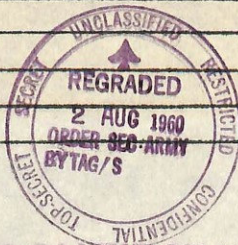

Dear Mr. Eliseo:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter, dated 10 March 1947, in which you forward a roster, in duplicate, of Unit I, Division IV, 95th Infantry Regiment, 92nd Division, LAC.

Special press release from Public Relations Office, AFWESPAC, dated 1 February 1946, stated that no applications for recognition of guerrilla units would be accepted by this headquarters after 15 March 1946. The recent press release from Public Relations Office, PHILRYCOM, announced the closing date of 15 March 1947 for the submission of claims for non-casualty recognition.

It is generally considered that all concerned have had ample opportunity to prepare applications for unit recognition. In the opinion of this headquarters, your request for an extension of the time limit mentioned above is not adequately justified and therefore, is not favorably considered.

Returned herewith are the rosters of the Unit I, Division IV, 95th Infantry Regiment, 92nd Division, LAC.

This decision does not preclude individual request for casualty recognition by injured personnel or their heirs. Upon request from interested individuals, appropriate casualty forms will be forwarded.
