Special press release from Public Relations Office, AFWESPAC, dated 1 February 1946, stated that no applications for recognition of guerrilla unit would be accepted by this headquarters after 15 March 1946. The recent press release from Public Relations Office, PHILRYCOM, further announced the closing date of 15 March 1947 for the submission of individual claims for non-casualty recognition.

It is considered that all concerned had ample opportunity to prepare unit applications for recognition by 15 March 1946. Your request for recognition of the rosters of Headquarters, 3rd Battalion, 119th Infantry, Datu Macabangan Alamada's Outfit was received by this headquarters 16 April 1947. It does not comply with the above closing date and therefore cannot be accepted for consideration.

This decision does not preclude submission of claims for casualty recognition by those individuals who are qualified and feel justified in entering such claims. Upon request from interested individuals, appropriate forms will be forwarded.

SUBJECT: Application for Recognition of Guerrilla Unit

TO: Commanding General, PHILRYCOM, APO 707
Mandaluyong, Rizal

1. Request recognition of Guerrilla Unit (Datu Macabangan Alamada's Outfit) organized and commanded by the undersigned since 1 August 1944 up to the date of its deactivation on 30 September 1945, then stationed at Katid-tuan, Cotabato, Mindanao Island.

2. Enclosed herewith are Rosters of Officers and men of the said outfit for the months of August and September, 1945. Rosters of Officers and Men covering the period from August 1, 1944 to 31 July 1945, which were left in Cotabato will be submitted to that Headquarters as soon as they are available in this Office.

3. The above request for recognition is made in view of the fact that most of the men in this unit have not been processed, thus depriving them of filing claims for benefits or compensation as members of a resistance movement who have so loyally served for the common cause.
