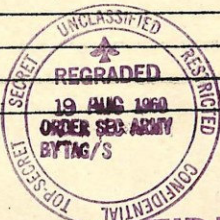

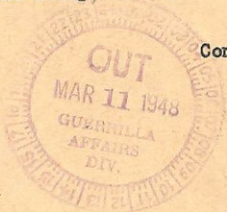
Lt Col Wallace M. Hanes:

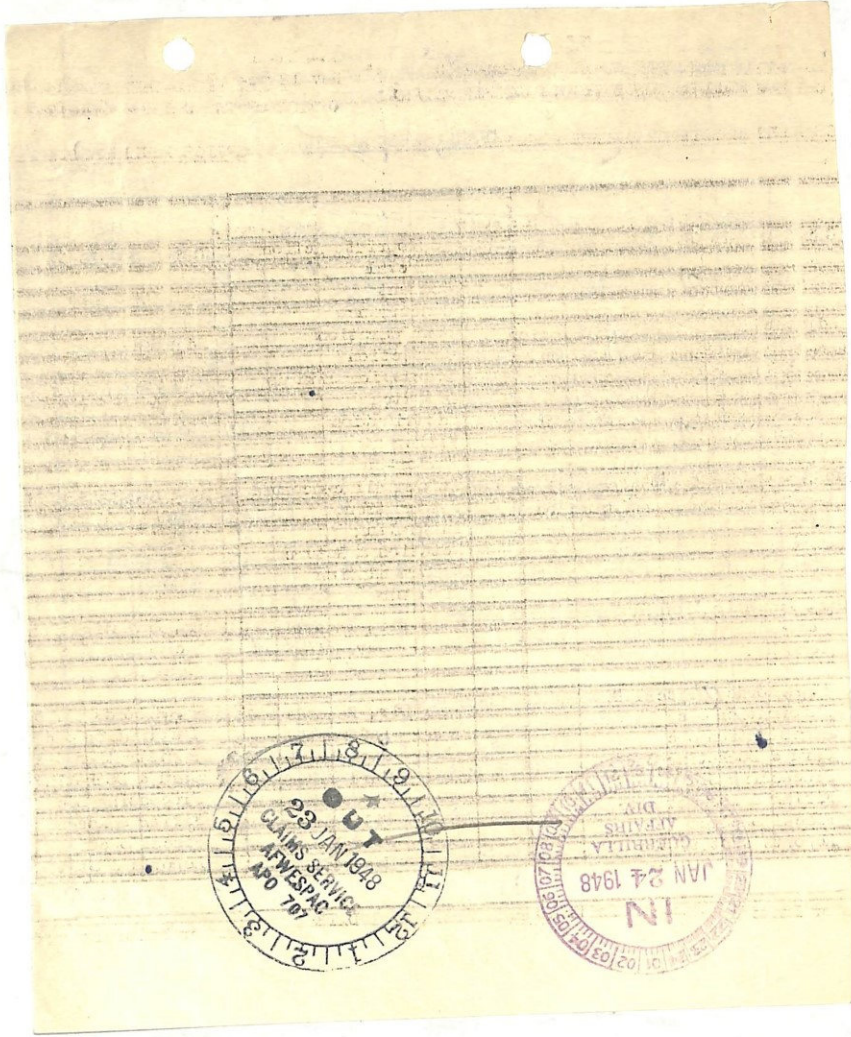

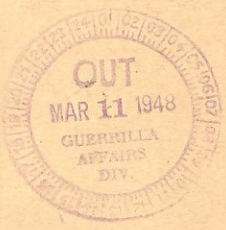

Dear Mr. Melchor:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that Squadron 425, Tarlac East Sector, USAF, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

- a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.
- b. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.
- c. Activities of this unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.
- d. Performance of the units did not indicate adequate control by its leaders.
- e. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization.
- f. Members of this unit did not devote their entire efforts to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations.

It is requested that you comply with the provisions of Executive Order No. 68, by the President of the Philippines, dated 26 September 1945, which is attached.

1. On 31 January 1947, Lt Delfin Jaranilla Jr., examined the unit file of "Squadron 425, Tarlac West Sector, IGAF."

2. ALLEGED HISTORY: (See attached unit file)

3. FINDINGS:

a. No field investigation was deemed necessary after a careful examination of the attached unit file.

b. Record of service of the subject unit was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. Other than allegations found in the submitted history, no proof of guerrilla activity was presented.

c. The unit was not maintained in the field in opposition to the enemy. As stated in par 2 of the submitted history, 425, "Acted as Home Guards thereby protecting the life and property of the civilians from being maraudered and taken by the enemy (Japs)".

d. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy. It appears that the subject unit did not engage the enemy alone in the two alleged encounters, for which no proof was submitted, but in conjunction with the 1st Tarlac Regt of ECLGA, an altogether different overall command. *(recognized)*

e. Performance of the unit did not indicate control by its leaders as there appears to be two rosters submitted: one an allegedly "activated roster" and the other a "Supplementary roster", the reason for which is not apparent and for which no explanation was made. Examination of the records in this office disclosed no recognized unit of that name.

f. Subject unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization. During the occupation subject unit claimed to have been "Home Guards", whose activities were of a negative character. Instances of alleged fighting against the Japanese were sporadic in nature, and occurred during the liberation.

g. Members of the subject unit did not devote their entire effort to military activity in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupations, inasmuch as it was primarily organized for "Home Guard" duty.

h. No useful purpose will be accomplished by further investigation of this unit as there are no members worthy of recognition and the unit suffered no casualties. No members have previously been recognized.

4. POLITICAL ASPECTS: This unit does not appear to have any political affiliations or aspirations.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS: It is recommended that "Squadron 425, Tarlac West Sector, IGAF," be not favorably considered for recognition.



1. 1 May 1943, up to the American Liberation members of this Squadron have had Pre-Military Training, and do some collective works regarding Japanese activities in the sector;
2. Acted as Home Guards thereby protecting the life and property of the civilians from being maraudered and from being taken by the enemy (Japs).
3. 18 January 1945, some officers and EM of the Squadron met the Liberating Forces at Bo. Salomague, Paniqui, Tarlac and have rendered due courtesy on these forces and help them patrol the municipality.
4. Help the Liberating Forces reconstruct the ruined Bridge at Bo. San Isidro, Paniqui, Tarlac, passed by the National Highway.
5. 8 February 1945, an squad of this squadron succeeded in capturing one enemy soldier (Jap) thereby inflicting several wounds on him and was brought to the Medical Department of the FIRST TARLAC REGIMENT, (ECLGA) for treatment.
6. On or about the middle part of May, 1945 thru the untiring efforts and spy works of this squadron, succeeded in detecting a number of Japs hiding by the bank of Taloy River, Paniqui, Tarlac, and there, upon direct report to the 632 T D BATTALION, U. S. Army stationed at Paniqui, Tarlac, succeeded in killing 53 enemy soldiers (Japs) with the help of the FIRST TARLAC REGIMENT, (ECLGA), and this Squadron.
7. Aside from these, this squadron is still at present on the alert of detecting enemy soldiers.
