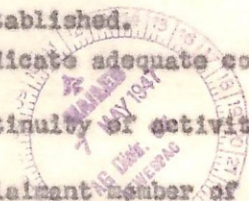
Dear Mr. Salvador:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the Salvador's Intelligence Unit, MFAT, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

- a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.
- b. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.
- c. A definite organization was not established.
- d. Performance of the unit did not indicate adequate control by its leaders.
- e. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization.

It is desired to emphasize that each claimant member of the unit is considered to have had just and adequate appraisal for recognition when his services were evaluated concurrently with this study of the unit with which he claims membership. Individual requests were not necessary nor appropriate then, or now, as their acceptance would in effect constitute unjustified duplication of consideration of one individual by this headquarters. However, this does not preclude submission for casualty recognition by those individuals who are qualified and feel justified in entering such claims. Upon request by interested individuals, appropriate forms will be forwarded.

SALVADOR'S INTELLIGENCE UNIT, M F A T

1. On 28 April 1947 Lts Breaz and de Rivera inspected the unit file of the Salvador Intelligence Unit, MFAT.

2. ALLEGED HISTORY: (See unit file)

3. FINDINGS:

a. After an examination of the unit file a field investigation was deemed unnecessary.

b. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. Unit history does not merit this unit's being considered as a guerrilla organization.

c. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy. This unit operated in Manila and most of its members lived in the city itself. It is more than certain that these men all lived at home. These men apparently devoted the greater part of their time to supporting their families (food in those days being scarce), and gathered intelligence only when such intelligence presented itself without a difficult search being necessary.

d. A definite organization was not established by this unit. The quotation in paragraph e. demonstrates a definite lack of organization.

e. Performance of the unit did not indicate adequate control by its commanding officer. To quote from the unit history: "Then some of my men went to the province so we lost the contact and we do not know where we can get in touch with the Commanding Officer."

f. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization. Recurrent throughout the unit history is the statement, "we lost again the contact". This "contact" was the outlet for their supposed intelligence reports. After losing a contact, and this apparently happened quite often, the unit's members "laid low" for a time. As of 10 Dec 44 this unit claims to have become a part of the "ROTC" because of loss of contact with the MFAT. Had this unit been an active unit of the ROTC, they would have undoubtedly been represented in the ROTC cadre roster. Since they were not, it is safe to assume they were not a bonafide guerrilla unit.

g. Cols Marking & Yay, MFAT when asked for recommendations concerning this unit were unable to give one. Neither knew of this unit's existence. The contact team was unable to locate T. Salvador CO, 1st A.C. for his recommendation.

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
h. There are no members worthy of recognition. There is no separate casualty roster; if one should be submitted, it is recommended that it be not favorably considered.


4. POLITICAL ASPECTS:

H I S T O R Y

It was in the middle of Sept. 1942 five months after the surrender of Corregidor, a certain fellow by the name of Liberato Ramirez a neighbor of ours approached me and wished that I be a member of the Marking's Guerrilla under Col. Hugh Straughn. At that time condition was delicate so that I told him I would think it over. Two days later he went back to me and give me news and informations about the organization and its genuineness and even showed me the confidential papers. I thought to myself that I would be of service to my country so I asked him application for membership. I was then a member and received contact and news of activities. Later I produced men to join the unit and I gathered more than a hundred. Induction papers reached me Dec. 11, 1942 dated Dec. 10, 1942, whereas other papers were not because Col. Enrique Zulaibar, our Superior Officer was caught by the Japanese and was tortured and killed, so as with Liberato Ramirez, our contact man who was shot by the Searching Party of the Constabulary. Some of our men were also picked up and myself too. I was set free after a week. Then some of my men went to the province so we lost the contact and we do not know where we could get in touch with the Commanding Officer.

Later we received news of the reorganization of the Marking's Guerrilla in the City of Manila and met Capt. Bonifacio M. Pereja Jr. who at that time was busy gathering men in the city. We were then under the command for sometime. Received verbal instructions to make lists of Pro-Japanese persons, make propaganda about United States arrival, and secured maps of Greater Manila in big scale indicating Japanese gun enplacements, warehouses, ammunition dumps, and anti-aircraft positions in every camp. The missions were always accomplished. Capt. Pereja Jr. was caught by the Japanese Kempei and was brought to Fort Santiago but was released four months later. Then he went to the mountains and we did not hear from him anymore. We lost again the contact. We keep low till we met a Liason Officer of the Hunters or ROTC guerrilla, under Col. Terry Magtangol. My men were again assigned to work for him actively in the Intelligence Corps, Greater Manila Sector, Dec. 10, 1943 under Major Juan Daza. We acted as intelligence operatives. We submitted reports every week. Later Major Daza was wanted for espionage job by the Japanese and so he hid in Malabon where we had our Headquarters. Then he was replaced by Major Joe Velasquez. Attached herewith are Memorandum and Orders. We made maps and records of Japanese positions. We handed in reports and made weekly changes if there were. Success was always made. Even our last report was a week before the landing of the American troops in Leyte.


