You were informed by letter, this headquarters, dated 1 August 1947, that your request for separate consideration of your unit constituted a new unit application for recognition which could not be accepted by this headquarters as it did not comply with the announced closing date of 15 March 1946 for the submission of such claims.



This will acknowledge receipt of your letter, dated 23 January 1947, in which you request information regarding the present status of the Nueva Ecija Unit, Fil-American Irregular Troops.

The Nueva Ecija Unit, Fil-American Irregular Troops, was not favorably considered for recognition by letter, Headquarters, AFWESPAC, to Mr. Ricardo G. Lloret, dated 21 March 1946.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, was used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit was not deemed to be warranted.

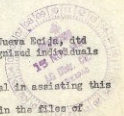

Sir:

We would like to ask information from you, concerning our guerrilla unit who have rendered services during the dark days, who encountered hardships and dangers, and up to now these services are not yet recognized by the AFWESPAC. We are a unit without a leader to fight for our recognition, due to the fact that our senior officer was beheaded by the brutal Japs. Our papers and records were all destroyed by the enemies when our late Capt. Casemero Panahon was caught by the Japs.

The late Capt. Casemero Panahon as per authority from the late Col. Hughes Strawn and the late Gen. Vicente Lim, began organizing our unit (Fil-American Irregular Troops) last Sept. 1942. After our services which is principally espionage and sabotage the said Capt. Casemero Panahon was caught last Oct. 3, 1944 and beheaded by the enemies at the evening of Oct. 4, 1944. We followers were left behind like chicks without mother to follow. We don't know whom to approach for the recognition of our boys who rendered services for the preservation of democracy and who fought for the cause. Being leaderless we attached our unit (San Jose, Nueva Ecilja unit) to a certain guerrilla outfit, the 103rd Inf. Regt. which was contacted by Lt. George Campbell last Dec. 7, 1945, believing that being attached to that outfit our recognition will be hastened. But contrary to our expectation it had turned from good to worst. Lt. George Campbell collected 43 of our arms composing of different kinds of rifles. From our attach to that outfit up to the present date we are fighting the bad elements (Huks) in our area, who want to erase the principles of democracy in our land and change it to communism.

My dear General, we have identification cards which proves that we are bonafide members of the F.A.I.T. We and my 122 boys can present affidavits signed by ranking officers of the organization, that will certify to the truth of our unit. At present we have still with us 40 arms composing of 1 Japs machine gun cal. .31, several US carabines, M1 garands, Japs rifles, and US pistols. This arms are being used by us during our operation against the Huks.

Any information concerning the recognition of our boys is highly appreciated by the undersigned officer, who was left alone to carry on the fight for the recognition of the boys.

Originally a company was formed with the undersigned as Company Commander with Captain Casimiro Panahon as the Executive Officer and Capts. Felipe Yand and Carmelo Quiboa as Junior Officers. However, realizing the extensive area to be covered and the possibility of obtaining sufficient number of officers to carry on the work it was decided that a regiment be formed with the following officers:

2nd Battalion - Captain Felipe Yusi

In December during that same year efforts were exerted to merge this unit with the Lapham-McKenzie Group but this move did not materialize because Major Lapham and Captain McKenzie doubted the veracity of the persons who stood for Charles B. Pierce and Edmund Ellsworth. Despite the explanation we made that General Lim was supposed to be Ellsworth and that Colonel Chioco was Pierce, the two American officers contended that if General Lim and Colonel Chioco were really sincere in their desire to form such organization, they should come out in the open. At that time, however, General Lim and Colonel Chioco were under strict surveillance and it was not possible for them to come out in the open. This disagreement has resulted in the disapproval of our plea to attach our unit with the Lapham group. However, there was a perfect harmony and excellent collaboration between the Lapham Group and the Fil-American Group for when the men of Major Lapham needed some money to buy firearms, it was the Fait that levied voluntary contributions from the civic spirited citizens. We were also responsible for the collection of money, medicine and food stuffs for their organization.

Due to lack of arms, the members of the Fait unit acted as spies for the guerrillas and when actual fight was going on between the Japs and Americans the members played an important role by sabotage work and by carrying messages from one U.S. camp to another. A number of the members attached themselves to the A. I. B. (Allied Intelligence Bureau) headed by Lieuts. Concha and Sabangbang, both of the A. I. B.

PERSONAL HISTORY OF THE C.O.

Upon my assignment as Company Commander of the Nueva Ecija Unit, I immediately organized a company with the following officers:

- Company Commander - Major Manuel Abellera
- S-1 Personnell - Captain Anselmo Patassil
- S-2 Intelligence Officer - Captain José V. Clarino
- S-3 Plans & Training - Captain Euanventura Eugenio
- S-4 Supply Officer - Captain Constancio Padilla

Efforts to affiliate this organization with the Lapham-McKenzie Group were made but the plan did not materialize because there was some doubt as to the Officers represented by Charles B. Pierce and Edmund P. Ellsworth. Despite our explanation that Pierce and Ellsworth were represented by Col. Chifoco and General Lim respectively, it was not accepted by Major Lapham, claiming that if these Officers were really sincere in their desire to organize a Unit, they should come out in the open. At that time, however, Col. Chifoco and General Lim were under strict surveillance, hence it was not possible for them to come out in the open. Despite this rejection by the Lapham group to attach the Pil-American Unit, there was perfect harmony and excellent collaboration of the two groups, the Pil-American giving all aids needed by the guerillas in that Area, such as money, medicine, foodstuff and supplies.

In a conference made by the Officers of guerillas in that area, the undersigned was made chairman in the collection of money, supplies and foodstuff and this job was carried out not only to the satisfaction of the guerillas but also to Major Lapham and Captain McKenzie and their soldiers. The amount of money collected by the undersigned alone was no less than Ten Thousand Pesos (P 10,000.00, not to mention the medicine, supplies and foodstuff given to the guerillas.

No arms were available at that time but my men and I engaged ourselves in sabotage work and spying against the enemy. Upon the arrival of the American forces in January, 1945, in Guimba, Muñoz and San Jose, many of my men in this Unit worked with the A.I.B. (Allied Intelligence Bureau) by gathering information regarding the enemy positions and the location of dumps of fuel and munition and in sending them to the A.I. B. under the leadership of Lieut. Concha and Lieut. Cabangbang, both of the A.I.B. The accurate shelling of the enemy positions including the dumps of fuel and munitions may be attributed to the reports submitted by my men including myself.

When the liberating forces arrived in Nueva Ecija, some of the members of our Unit attached themselves to various American Outfits and this partly resulted to the reduction of members and Officers in our Unit.

It might be of interest to mention in this connection that sometime in September, 1944, our Regimental Commander, Major Panahon, ExUSSAFFE Officer, was killed by the Japanese because of his activities as a guerilla so that after his death, the undersigned, being the ranking officer of the Unit, took command of the organization until the American forces arrived in January, 1945. As C. O. of the Outfit, I had to travel to the different barrios to inspire and encourage the members fearing that the death of the Regimental Commander might lessen their loyalty. It was found, however, that the members did not lose hope; on the other hand, they were determined to push on the job and fight for the noble cause for which America was fighting. As a result of this activity,

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I was arrested by the Japs in November, 1944 accusing me of the following charges :

1. That I was a Major of the Guerillas
2. That I was the chief financial officer of the Guerillas in that area.
3. That I used to hold conferences with Guerillas leaders in the barrios including Major Lapham and Captain McKeagle.

The above accusations were all true but fortunately the Garizon commander could not get any evidence against me so I was released after a day in the Garizon. Not contented with this investigation, four Japanese Military Police raided my house one day in December, 1944, and examined all documents found in our house. Fortunately no documents pertaining to our guerilla activities could be dug out by them and I was finally exonerated.

Despite the above incidents, we have not given hope for a better day. Our activities continued as usual until January when the Americans arrived in our territory.
