It was included in the (105rd Regiment which, the writer understands, was turned down. In justice to the deserving guerrillas, reconsideration is requested for this unit headed by the writer, Belarmino Gueto.

The Nueva Ecija Unit, Fil-American Irregular Troops, was not favorably considered for recognition by letter, Headquarters, AFWESPAC, to Mr. Ricardo G. Lloret, dated 21 March 1946.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, was used as a guide in considering the record of After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit was not deemed to be warranted.

Sir:

We would like to ask information from you, concerning our guerrilla unit who have rendered services during the derk days, who encountered hardships and dangers, and up to now those services are not yet recognized by the AFWEFAC. We are a unit without a leader to fight for our recognition, due to the fact that our senior officer was beheaded by the brutal Japs. Cur papers and records were all destroyed by the enemies when our late Capt. Cassmero Panahon was caught by the Japs.

The late Capt. Gasemero Panahon as per authority from the late Gol. Hughes Straughn and the late Gen. Vicenthe Lim, beginned organizing our unit (Fil-imerican Irregular Troops) last Sept. 1942. After our services which is principally espionage and sabotage the said Gapt. Casemero Panahon was caught last Oct. 3, 1944 and beheaded by the chandes at the evening of Oct. 4, 1944. We followers were left behind like chicks without mother to follow. We don't know whom to approach for the recognition of our boys who rendered services for the preservation of democracy and who fought for the cause. Being leaderless we attached our unit (San Jose, Nueva Ecija unit) to a certain guerrilla outfit, the 103rd Int. Regt. which was contacted by Lt. George Campbel last Bec. 2, 1945, believing that being attached to that outfit our recognition will be hastened. But contrary to our expectation it had turned from good to worst. It. George Campbel collected 45 of our arms composing of different kinds of rifles. From our attach to that outfit up to the present date we are fighting the bad elements (Huks) in our area, who want to crase the principles of democracy in our land and change it to communism.

My dear General, we have identification cards which proves that we are bonafide members of the r.A.I.T. He and my 122 boys can present affidavits signed by ranking efficers of the organization, that will certify to the truth of our unit. At present we have still with us 40 arms composing of I Japs machine gun Ual. 31, several US carbines, MI garands, Japs rifles, and US pistols. This arms are being used by us during our operation against the Huke.

Any information concerning the recognition of our boys is highly appreciated by the undersigned officer, who was left alone to carry on the fight for the recognition of the boys.

Originally a company was formed with the undersigned as Company Commender with Captula Casimiro Panahon as the Executive Officer and Capts. Felipe Yask and Cammalo Quiban as Junior Officers. However, realizing the extensive area to be covered and the possibility of obtaining sufficient number of officers to carry on the work it was decided that a regiment be formed with the following officers:

In December during that same year efforsts were exerted to merge this unit with the Lapham-McKenzie Group but this move did not materialize beeause Major Lapham and Captain McKenzie doubted the veracity of the persons who stood for Charles B. Pierce and Edmund Ellsworth. Despite the explanation we made that General Lim was supposed to be Ellsowrth and that Colonel · Chioco was Pierse, the two American officers contended that if General Lim and Colonel Chioco were really sincere in their desire to form such orgenization, they should some out in the open. At that time, however, General Lim and Colonel Chicco were under strict surweillance and it was not possible for them to come out in the open. This disagreement has resulted in the disapproval of our plea to attach our unit with the Lapham group. However, there was a perfect harmony and excellent collaboration between . the Lapsham Group and the Fil-American Group for when the men of Major Lapham needed some mency to buy firearms, it was the Fait that levied voluntary contributions from the civic spirited citizens. We were also responsible for the collection of money, medicine and food stuffs for their (. organization,

Due to lack of arms, the members of the Fait unit acted as spics for the guerrillas and when actual fight was going on between the Japs and Americans the members played an important role by sabottege work and by corrying massages from one U.S. camp to another. A number of the members attached themselves to the A. I. B. (Allied Intelligence Bureau) headed by Licuts.

PERSONAL HISTORY OF THE C.O.

Upon my assignment as Company Commander of the Mueva Ecija Unit, I immediately organized a company with the following officers:

Company Commander - Major Manuel Abellera 5-1 Personnell - Captain Anselmo Pataesil 5-2 Intelligence Officer - Captain Jose V. Clarino 5-3 Plans & Training - Captain Euchaventura Eugenio 5-4 Supple Officer - Captain Constancio Padilla

Lapham-Mckenzie Group were made but the plan did not materialize because there was some doubt as to the Officers represented by Charles B. Pierce and Edmund P. Eliworth. Despite our explanation that Pierce and Eliworth were represented by Col.Chioco and General Lim respectively, it officers were really sincere in their desire to organize a Unit, they should dome out in the open. At that time, however, Col. Chioco and General Lim were under strict survillance, hence it was not possible for them to come out in the open. Despette this rejection by the Lepham group to attach the Fil-American Unit, there was perfect harmony and excellent collaboration of the two groups, the Fil-American giving all aids needed by the guerillas in that Area, such as money, medicine, foodstuff and surplies.

In a conference made by the Officers of guerillas in that area, the undersigned was made chairman in the collection of money, supplies and foodstuff and this job was carried out not only to the satisfaction of the guerillas but also to lajor Laphan and Captain Rokenzie and their soldiers. The ambunt of money collected by the undersigned alone was no less than Ten Thousand Pesos (P 10,000,00, not to mention the medicine, supplies and foodstuff given to the guerillas.

No arms were available at that time but my men and I engaged ourselves in sabbotage work and spying against the enemy. Upon the arrival of the American forces in January, 1945, in Guimba, lanos and San Jose, Many of my men in this Unit worked with the A.I.B. (Allied Inteeligence Bureau) by gathering information regarding the enemy positions and the location of dumps of fuel and munition and in sending them to the A.I.B. under the leadership of Lieut. Concha nad Lieut. Cabayingbang, both of the A.I.B. The accurate shelling of the enemy positions including the dumps of fuel and munitions may be attributed to the reports submitted by my men including myself.

When the liberating forces arrived in Nueva Ecija, some of the members of our Unit attached themselves to various American Outfits and this partly republishes to the reduction of members and Officers in our Unit.

It might be of interest to mention in this connection that sometime in September, 1944, our Regimental Commander, Major Panahon, ExUSSAFFE Officer, was killed by the Japanese because of his activities as a guerilla so that after his death, the undersigned being the ranking officer of the Unit took command of the organization until the American forces arrived in January, 1945. As C. O. of the Outfit, I had to travel to the different barrios to inspire and encourage the members fearing that the death of the Regiemental Commander might lessen their loyalty. It was found, however, that the members did not lose hope; on the other hand, they were determined to push on the job and fight for the noble cause for which America was fighting. As a result of this activity,

Fortunately no documents pertaining to our guerilla activities could be dug out by them and I was finally exonerated. Despite the above incidents, we have not given hope for a better day. Our activities continued as usual until January when the Americans arrived in our territory.
