



Dear Mr. Lustre:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter, dated 29 December 1947, resubmitting the Supplementary Roster of Squadron 25, Battalion 3, Regimental Command 8, Hukbalahap, for recognition.

It is desired to inform you that a special press release from Public Relations Office, Headquarters, AFWESFAC, dated 1 February 1946, announced the closing date of 15 March 1946 for the acceptance of unit applications for recognition. It must be clarified that the closing date of 31 December 1947, announced by the Recovered Personnel Division of this headquarters, applied to the filing of claims for arrears in pay for military service rendered in the USAFFE or in recognized guerrilla organizations. This closing date and several subsequently announced closing dates did not apply to any unrecognized guerrilla personnel.

Inasmuch as the Supplementary Roster of Squadron 25, Battalion 3, Regimental Command 8, Hukbalahap, which you have submitted in your letter of 29 December 1947, was previously submitted by your commanding officer and was returned to him for reason of late submission; and as there has been no extension of the closing date of 15 March 1946 for the submission of unit applications for recognition, it is again necessary to return the rester of that unit.



Squadron 25 raided mountains of Bataan purposely for firearms and ammunition.

- (b) We made several encounters against the enemy during those period as a result of which we killed numerous Japanese in the different places mentioned in the Chromological History of Squadron 25 hereto attached.
- (c) then Col. 70se de Loon, alias Dissealing submitted the roster of his troops, he intentionally contrad Squadron 25, Edicales 9 Guarille Forces with the belief that Commander Repoless shall also usualt the roster of his troops, 50, 25, The Laber busher his direct command, Das to frequent encounnisation of our roster. Labet these, That delayed the submission of our roster.
- Attach herewith is the chronological history of Squadron 25, Rukbalshap Guerilla Forces from the time it was organized up to the time it was demobilized.
- 3. In view of the foregoing facts and in justice to those who worked for the liberation of our people against the enemy and in behalf of those who died for the same cause, it is earnestly requested that this unit be recognized.

CHRONOLOGICAL HISTORY OF SQUADRON 25

HUKBALAHAP Battalion No. S. Regimental Command No. 8

SAN ANTONIO, NUEVA ECIJA

29th May 1942- The Japanese Imperial Forces led by a handful of Ganaps raided the sitio of Bentug in the barrio of San Francisco, San Antonio, Nueva Ecija and surrounded all the houses in the said place. All the people were assembled irrespective of sex and age and at the instigation of the Genera the following persons were separated from the group and in the presence of all were bayonetted and killed: 1. Jacinto Julian 2. Fabian Cabrera 3. Dominador Javier 4. Apolonio Justeo

5. Daniel Soriano 6. Unidentified These barbarous acts committed by the Japanese were deeply resented by the people.

Slat July 1942-again, while the above atrocities were still fresh in the minds of the people, another inhuman and barbarous act was committed by the Japanese soldiers in sitio Bulacan in the barrio of San Francisco, San Antonio, Nueva Ecija. The fol-

lowing persons were tied in two groups: 2nd Gro 1. Arcadio Bueneventure 1. Mrs. Vicente Urbeno 2. Mrs. Viesca 2. Arsenio Basa 3. Peyes 3. A girl, 4 yrs. old These people were tortured, besten and thrown into a ditch

and burned alive. The Japanese soldiers and Genaps also burned fifteen houses at the same time and looted all their personal effects. With all these atrocities and barbarous acts of the Japanese the people voluntarily banded together, armed themselves and constituted themselves into a guerilla unit to be known later as SQUAIRON 25, Battalion 3, Regimental Command No. 8, HUKBALAHAP, under the command of Capt. Antonio Paz y Carlos, alias Datu Telim, with 165 men who were fully armed.

9th Aug 1942- A platoon of Japanese soldiers with some members of the Gamers raided the sitio of Calumpang in the barrio of San Jose of this municipality. They encountered Squadron 10, Hukbalahap, under the command of Major Fajardo. In the meantime, Squadron 25 deployed along the road leading to barrio San Francisco

and took battle positions waiting for the return of the Japanese and the Gamaps. When they retreated to barrio San Francisco, Squadron 25 and other Squadrons of the Hukbalahaps opened fire. 10th Aug 1942-The Japanese soldiers and Gamps were completely encircled in the sitio of Minanglo, berric of San Francisco, Realizing their predicament, they entrenched themselves in the house of Don Julio Gallego and made a desperate attempt to defend themselves. In


this encounter numerous Japanese soldiers and Gemaps were killed and arms of various types were captured. 3rd Sept 1942- The Japanese soldiers and Genaps reided the berrio of Laweng Cupang and encountered Squadron 25 therein. Fierce fighting took place but because Squadron 25 was outnumbered, they were forced to retreat after killing five Japanese soldiers. Casualties on

the side of Squadron 25 were fifteen men. Squadron 25 and another Squadron known as Rosali were in barrio 25 Oct 1942-Rejal, Sta. Rosa, Mueva Ecija. They were raided by Japanese soldiers. After a short skirmish they retreated to Aliaga, Nueva Ecija. No casualty was sustained therein.

Nov 1942-A barrio in Quezon, Rusva Ecija was raided by Japanese soldiers. A short skirmish followed. Squadron 25 killed six Japanese soldiers and captured several firearms. 5 Dec 1942-

Barrão Pinagpandayan, Guimba, Nueva Ecija. Squadron 25 ambushed a truckload of Japanese patrol and killed Shree of them. Squa-

dron 25 suffered no casualty.

Jan 1945- The Japanese soldiers commandeered and threshed the palay of all the tenants of Don Pablo Tecson and these of Emilio Lorenzo, Crispulo Sideco and some others located in barrio San Mariano of this municipality. The palay were stored in the camarin of Don Pablo Tecson and guarded by Japanese soldiers and Makapilis. Squadron 25 and Squadron 28, Hukbalahaps, attacked the Japanese soldiers and Makapilis stationed within the premises of the camarin. The Japanese retreated in Jaen, Nueva Ecija, while four Makapilis were captured by Squadron 25. The remnants of the palay stored in the camarin were distributed among the needy civilians. From them on the Headquarters of Squadron 25 was established in the municipal government building of San Antonio, Nueva Ecija under the direct command of Capt. Felipe C. Villas, alias Napoleon, who took direct command of \$f\$ Squadron 25 in December, 1943.

Dec 1943- Capt. Antonio Paz y Carlos, alias Datu Talim, with his staff surrendered to Col. Nagahama, Chief of the Japanese Military Police in Jaen, Nueva Ecija.

Tabing Sapa, San Mariano, San Antonio, N.E.

6 Japanese were killed & 6 rifles captured.

Jan 1945- Mantama, Sto. Cristo, San Antonio, N. E. Squadron 25 and some American soldiers under the command of Capt. Earnest rilled one Japanese soldiers and one rifle was captured.

Jan 1945- Squadron 25, while on patrol duty in sitio Hitukang Manok, barrio of Papays, San Antonio, Nawer Soijs, oncountered three Japaness coldiers and siter a short skirnish was able to kill them, capturing one Lewis sub-machine gun, one pistol and ten rifles.

Jan 1945- Squadron 25 was attached to the 6th Army with the verigal consent of Col. MoMain, with Headquarters at Capen, Rusva Roija who provided Squadron 25 with 10,000 rounds of ammunition for firearms of verious kind and caliber.
