Deer Mr. Villoflor:

The Communing General has directed that you be informed that the Mon Christian Tribes Teales Unit, Church of the Philippines, purporting to be a generalian organization under your nominal control, is not fororably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for gwerrilla recognition, established by General Resetther during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substending records and testimony of winasses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be marranted because of resone sentioned below:

- a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable syldence.
- b. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the energy.
- e. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defect of the enemy.
 - d. Performence of the unit did not indicate adequate control by its leaders, because the communing officer joined another unit.
- e. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and openization.
- f. Members of the unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal sivilian occupation and family obligations.

Report on Non Christian Tribes Ibalao Unit

- 1. It E. Sta. Romana on 10 February 1947, examined the unit file of Non Christian Tribes, Ibalao Unit.
 - 2. ALLEGED HISTORY: (No attached unit History)
 - 3. FINDINGS:
- a. No field investigation was deemed necessary after careful examination of the attached unit file.
- b. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. After careful consideration of all documentary evidence in the unit file, it is concluded that this unit did not exist as a guerrilla organization during the Japanese occupation. The documentary evidence on file with this unit were appointment of Y. Vilitor as Set of Folice of the Mon Christian Tribes Organization, dated 22 Feb 1936, signed by Secretary to the President of the Commonwealth of the Philippines an appointment signed by the Provincial Governor of Naver Soijs in 1936, and induction into the Mon Christian Tribes signed by Hishop Sem Evon of the Non Christian Tribes. During the Japanese occupation that Commanding Officer, Villaflor, received authority from the Commanding Officer of Squadron 303 to collect rice from the civilians for the use of Squadron 303 the Squadron 303 and was recognized as Sengeant with that unit. This indicates just acknowledgment of his military services rendered.
- c. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy. In the unit file there was no evidence that the unit actively opposed the enemy. They were in no sense a guerrilla organization.
- d. Activities of this unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy. Claims submitted were for helping the guerrilles by giving rice, maintaining peace and order and protecting themselves from the lawless elements. The Commanding Orfore this unit satisfied to Squadron 303 from 1922 up to the tiberation. The 29 sem were left in town to continue their normal duties for the lon Christian Trices. This indicates that the Non Christian Tribes, Theleo Unit, was not a guerrille unit. The activities of this unit were individual, and not those of an organization.
- e. Performance of the unit did not indicate adequate control by its leaders. The duties performed by the 29 mm under the Non Christian Tribes more voluntary and for the interest of the Non Christian Tribes only. The Commanding Officer left the organization early in 1942, and joined Squadron 309.



- f. The unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization. No evidence was submitted to support claims of guerrilla activities.
 - 6. Members of this unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations. The members appearedly lived in their homes and engaged in Non Christian Tribes activities within the town and the surrounding Eurice.
 - h. It is noted that V. Villaflor uses his appointment by the Secretary of Mawwa Edja and his induction into Non Christian Tribes by Sam Brown, Bishop of the organization, to request recognition of this unit.
 - i. No useful purpose will be accomplished by further investigation of this unit. There are no members worthy of recognition and no evidence was submitted to support the claims of those 15 casualties alleged to have been sustained by this unit.
 - 4. POLITICAL ASPECTS: This unit does not appear to have any political affiliations or aspirations.
 - 5. RECOMMEDATIONS: It is recommended that the Non Christian Tribes Ibalao Unit be not considered for recognition.






