Your letter dated 3 February 1946 relative to the activities of the Civilian Scouts, Antipolo, Camarines Sur, addressed to the United States tion.

The information relative to the personnel and activities of the organization under your nominal control indicates that the members of the unit were not actually maintianed in the field nor did they devote their entire efforts to military activity to the exclusion of normal civilian pursuits.

In view of the foregoing recognition of the Civilian Scouts, Antipolo, Camarines Sur, does not appear to be warranted. However, if documentary evidence of the guerrilla activities of this unit is available, this evidence may be submitted and will receive due consideration.
