Dear Mr. Daing:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the First Vinzons Regiment, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.

b. Rank of members was considered to be too high for the actual size of the command maintained in the field.

c. The number of officers, commissioned and non-commissioned, was excessive and not reasonably proportionate to the United States Army or to pre-war Philippine Army tables of organization.

d. Performance of the unit did not indicate adequate control by its leaders, because of:

- (1) Lawless acts committed against the civil population.
- (2) Unwarranted attacks on other guerrilla units.

e. Sphere of operations and unit strength claimed by the unit were not commensurate with the degree of anti-resistance activities of the Japanese in the area during the period concerned.

REPORT ON THE FIRST VINZON'S REGIMENT TURKO'S COMMAND

1. MISSION:

On 2nd July 1947 Captain S. C. Buchanan made a careful examination of the unit file of the "First Vinzon's Regiment" of ^{Uy}Turko's command. A field investigation was not deemed necessary.

2. HISTORY: See attached unit file.

3. FINDINGS: The following person was interviewed and his statement is reflected in the findings:

Capt Robert L Morton , GAD Hq, PHILRYCOM

a. The unit's record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. In the chronology of the subject unit's activities several preposterous claims are made. The composers of the unit history make the fantastic assertion that, beginning an offensive against the Japs on 28 February 1942, the Vinzon's Guerrilla Infantry (mother unit of subject unit) killed 1000 Japs daily for an unspecified length of time. The unit history ^{CONTINUES} continues in the same vein and references to encounters with the Japs at later dates, when totalled give the following summary: 328 Japs killed to 1 (one) guerrilla killed and 8 wounded. The only shred of evidence produced in the unit's behalf, outside the unit history, is a supposed true copy of a letter from a Woodrow H Hobbs, 1st Lt Cav. In this letter Lt Hobbs merely asks Capt de Anong, of the subject unit, to see him personally regarding "this matter." Certainly nothing so vague could be considered in a light to warrant the recognition of even one guerrilla.

b. Rank of members was considered to be too high for the actual size of the command maintained in the field. In a unit much smaller than an American Battalion the subject unit had six field grade officers to our two and fifteen Captains to our six.

c. The number of officers, commissioned and non-commissioned, was excessive and not reasonably proportionate to the United States Army or to the pre-war Philippine Army tables of organization. Of a total of 764 men the subject unit had 48 officers. While this figure is not as top heavy as some of the claimant guerrilla units have presented for recognition, it is definitely in excess of the above mentioned T/O's.

d. Sphere of operations and unit strength claimed by the unit were not commensurate with the degree of anti-resistance activities of the Japanese in the area during the period concerned. Paragraph "a" adequately demonstrates the grossness of

the exaggerated claims made by the organization in question.

The First Vinzon's Regiment was organized from the dissolved remnants of the Vinzons Guerrillas on 6 August 1942. It joined Turko's Command on 23 May 1943 and was an integral part of it from that time on. Capt R L Morton, of this office, investigated Turko's Command in the month of January 1946 and recommended that it be not favorably considered. Capt Morton said that the subject unit was considered at this time and that, in his opinion, his TLR on Turko's Command covered the unit in question. However, the "First Vinzons Regiment" was not mentioned, as such, in his TLR and the undersigned deemed a second report necessary to answer the subject unit's request for recognition.

4. POLITICAL ASPECTS: The unit ~~very possibly~~ has some definite political aspects since Turko at present is the mayor of Daet and, reportedly, is planning on running for Governor of Camarines Sur.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS:

a. That the "First Vinzons Regiment" of Turko's Command, be not favorably considered for recognition.

b. That any casualties claimed by the subject unit be studied individually.

c. That no recommendation can be made for any revision of dates for the 396 members of Turko's Command who have been previously recognized since the evidence examined is not applicable to them.

2. The supplementary roster submitted March 15, 1946 called 2nd Vinzons Regiment which included all newly recovered members recently found by Major Leopoldo B. de Anong who made a trip to Bicol Region to contact Lt. Morton of the AFWESPAC Guerilla Affairs section assigned there for investigation.

3. The 2nd Vinzons Regiment supplementary roster, Lt. Col. Ponciano O. Olayta as Commanding Officer, and Gonzalo C. Israel as Executive Officer, for the purpose of recognition, submitting immediately action in compliance of the AFWESPAC requirement. For the purpose, any officer of the 1st Vinzons Regiment may be assigned to help in the organization of supplementary roster new Unit.

4. I have already submitted supporting papers chronological history of activities during the Japanese resistance movement since 1942 to 1945.


5. I am included in casualty list in the supplementary roster 2nd Vinzons Regiment because I was treated by the Guerilla Medical Officer from Aug. 28, to Sept. 1943 for injuries in line of duty during the engagement against the Japanese. And Jan. 1, 1944 to 12, 1944 I was treated in the Hospital in line of duty with complete certificate from the Medical Officer on duty.

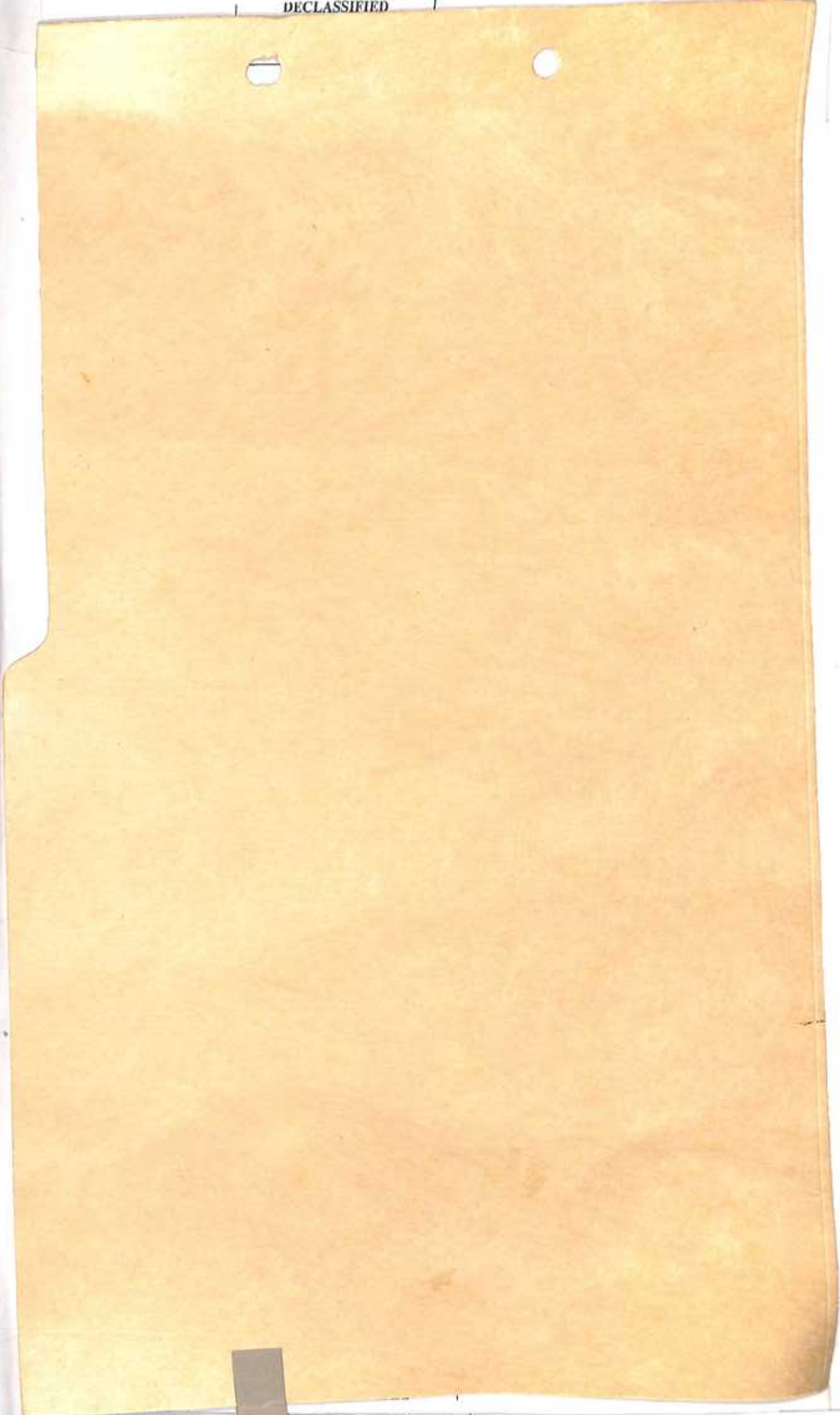
6. The month of Sept. 1946, I was attacked by rheumatic and last week, because this sickness it calms and attack, which was taken during the resistance movement.

7. Explanation, my name is not omitted in the roster because all our roster submitted Jan. 29, 1946, and supplementary rosters submitted March 15, 1946, no one has yet been released for official recognition by the AFWESPAC.



Receipt is acknowledged of your letter dated 7 August 1946, in which you requested information regarding the status of restora, and recognition of Leopoldo S. de Anong as a guerrilla casualty and your own recognition as an individual Guerrilla.

The information you seek regarding the status of the two restora can be secured from the Commanding Officers of the said units or Headquarters Philippine Army, APO 75.

Individual guerrillas who were seriously wounded or killed or served in any military operation against the enemy will be considered for individual recognition. It is not required that such individuals shall have belonged to a recognized guerrilla unit. Recognition will depend on whether or not there is established a satisfactory record of resistance to the enemy.

Recognition of casualties belonging to an unrecognized guerrilla unit will not be accepted as a basis for a claim for recognition by the remainder of the unit.

It is requested that there be forwarded to this headquarters the enclosed form completed in triplicate according to enclosed instruction sheet and letter entitled, "Information Concerning Guerrilla Casualties."



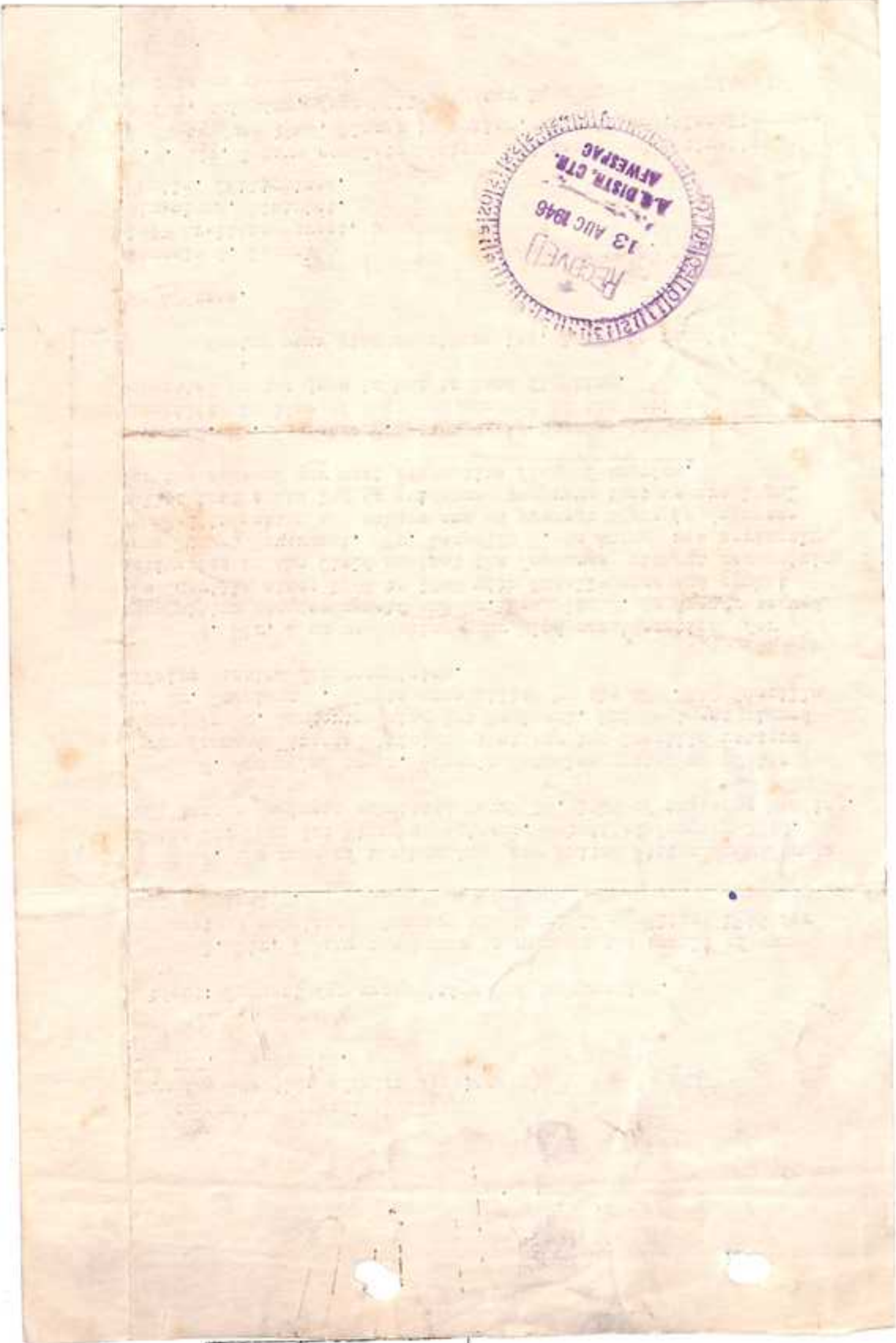

10 July 42 - Vinzon's Guerilla broke
GUERRILLA ACTIVITIES OF 1st. VINZONS REGIMENT (ILLAS)

12 July 42 C H R O N O L O G Y
Vinzon's who was heavily guarded in Daet by the

6 Aug 42 Capt. de Anong gathered the scattered men and reorganized them.

The history of this unit is traced back to the middle part of February, 1942 by Captain Leopoldo de Anong, an ROTC graduate, when he joined the organization of Rep. Wenceslao Q. Vinzon (RIP) in Camarines Norte. Capt. De Anong helped Rep. Vinzon organize the first guerilla unit. The first activity of the organization was to campaign for arms and ammunition as well as provisions and supplies which were immediately needed. Especial equipment such as radio transmitter and receiver were procured.

The Following chronology of the activities of this unit shows the important events in the history of the organization:

28 Feb 42 - The Vinzon's Guerilla Infantry started the offensive against the Japs by attacking all enemy positions and garrisons within the jurisdiction of Camarines Norte with 1,000 Japs reported killed daily. Vinzon's unit kept contact with Bataan HQ by transmitter, later with Australia when GHQ transferred there. Continuous operations against the Japs until recapture of Daet, Bagasbas Airfield, Talisay and Indan. After the recapture of said places, the Vinzon's infantry continued attacking the enemy remnants at Labo, Paracale Line, and Manila South Road until 16 April 42.

20 April 42-8 May 42 - After the surrender of Bataan and Corregidor, the Jap forces sent troops to Camarines Norte to aid the remaining Japs there. The Vinzon's unit resisted by heavy fighting, blasting enemy armoured trucks and demolishing bridges to stop enemy offensive.

9 May 42 Vinzon's Guerilla units were outnumbered by arrival of Jap reinforcements, and Commander Vinzon's ordered transfer of main units to Tulay na Lupa, his HQ, to rest and observe enemy movements and keep all arms and ammunition safe.

19 June 42 - Commander Vinzon's place located and heavily raided. Patrol units struck at Japs whenever there was opportunity by sniping them individually or in small groups.

8 July 42 - Commander Vinzon's was captured by the Japs at their hideout at Verica, Labo, with his family.

10 July 42 - Vinzons Guerilla broke up into small units.

12 July 42 Capt. Leopoldo de Anong tried to contact Vinzons who was heavily guarded in Daet by the Japs.

6 Aug 42 Capt. de Anong gathered the scattered men and reorganized Vinzons guerilla units. Proceeded to Tulay na Lupa and dug up the arms buried when commander Vinzons was captured by the Japs.

5 Sept 42 - The guerilla boys under Capt. de Anong's command left Cam. Norte with 18 U.S. rifles and 1,000 rounds ammunition and proceeded to Tayabas area to procure more arms and ammunition.

10 Oct 42 - The above command left Tagkawayan Zigzag at Tayabas area for Cam. Norte with several U.S. rifles and more ammunition.

2 Nov 42 - Capt. de Anong's unit fought the enemy at Lagkawayan area. Killed 42 Japs. Our casualties: 1 killed in action. Name: Tito Zafra. We captured several Jap rifles and a thousand rounds of ammunition.

12 Dec 42 - Had another heavy fight at Kinatukan Station at Tayabas. Killed 75 Japs. On our side, three men wounded.

Feb-Mar 43 - Heavy enemy raids searching for guerillas night and day at Tulay na Lupa and Bakalay mountains.

27 Mar 43 - Units left Cam. Norte for Tigbinan, Tayabas area and Cam. Sur to attack enemy points there.

22 Apr 43 - Attacked Jap garrison at Catabagnan, Cam. Sur. 16 Japs Killed.

23 May 43 - Units of Vinzons guerillas joined with Turko's guerilla organization.

20 June 43 - Vinzons' units under Capt. de Anong left Cam. Norte ~~wixk~~ for Tayabas for arms and ammunition campaign.

15 Jan 45 - Units returned to Caramon proper.

8 July 43 - Returned to Cam. Norte.

24 Feb 45 - Units under Capt. Leopoldo de Anong contacted 16 Aug 43 - Units under Capt. de Anong's command fought at Masalang, Labo, Cam. Norte and killed 42 Japs. Destroyed two enemy armoured trucks.

22 Aug 43 - Fought again at Pakalay, Labo, Cam. Norte. 22 Japs killed.

Chronology -

14 Sept 43 - Vinzons guerilla units were attacked by 78 Japs and 24 Filipino Jap P.C. at the barrio of Daguit, Labo, Cam. Norte, at 3:00 O'clock AM. Five men were seriously wounded. Their names:

1. Capt. Leopoldo de Anong 4. Antonio Tabalan
2. Florentino Salcedo 5. Gregorio Cabacugnan
3. Mateo Vilaverde 6. Prudencio Ibayan -

20 April 44 - Fought at Lippinan area. 20 Japs killed. 5 May 45 - Fought at Lippinan area. 5 Japs killed. In this action 15 Japs and 1 Jap officer name of Capt. Atsuki were killed.

26 Sept 43 - The wounded men who participated in above engagement were relayed by civilians to the Bahi, Cam. Sur Hospital for proper treatment.

16 Nov 43 - Wounded men were released from the hospital. Medical officers in attendance were:

1. Lt. Felizardo Alarkon 3. Lt. Bienvenido Sanchez
2. Lt. Melanio Teoxon 4. Lt. Miranda Primavera

2 Dec 43 - Patrol units headed by Capt. de Anong were sent to Paniman, Cam. Sur to prevent the enemy from entering Caramaon, Cam. Sur Peninsula.

24 Jan 44 - Units in Tayabas campaigning for more arms and ammunition.

4 Mar 44 - Engaged the enemy at Mabato-bato. 20 Japs killed.

8 Mar 44 - 250 Japs intercepted at Laboylaboyan, Lagonoy, Cam. Sur. 32 Japs killed.

12 Mar-Apr 44 - Headquarters transferred from Caramaon proper to Denrica and Carucat, Lagonoy, Cam. Sur, because of heavy enemy raids.

8 Dec 44 - Units left Cam. Sur for Cam. Norte.

10 Jan 45 - Engaged enemy at Talobatib. 17 Japs killed.

15 Jan 45 - Units returned to Caramaon proper.

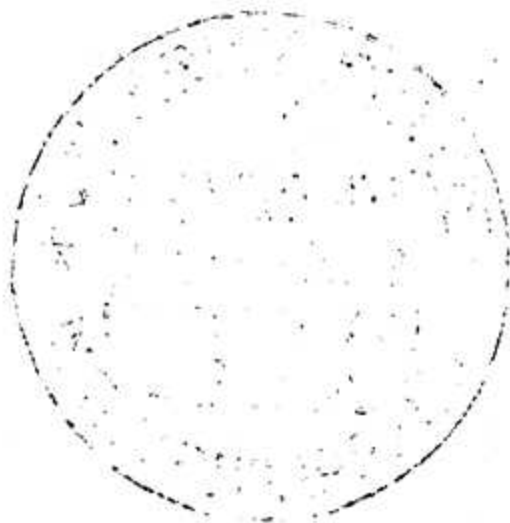

SUBJECT : Certificate of Treatment

TO : Whom It May Concern

This is to certify that Capt. Leo. B. de Anong was treated by this office; and the following facts are hereby presented for the information of those concerned:

On or about 3:00 AM Sept 14/43 together with several soldiers of the Guerillas, he was surprised by Jap soldiers at Barrio Daguit, Labo, Cam. Norte near Manila South Road.

As a result of the said encounter, Capt Leo. de Anong received the following bullet wounds from Japs rifle fire:

One wound at the inner side of the left thigh, penetrating about 4 inches from the epidermis; the bullet after traversing 4 inches passed thru the skin.

Another bullet wound piercing the gastronomic muscles at its lower end, following a downward and forward course along the outer margin of the gastronomic muscle, the bullet being thus embedded in the superficial tissues. The bullet can be palpated at several points along the outer margin of the said muscle and can be dislodged to other points within the outer side of the muscle.

He was taken to Bahi, Caramoan Dispensary on Sept 25, 1943 for treatment. The following medical officers attended him:

1. Capt. Melencio Teoxon (Dr.)
2. Lt. Felisardo Alarcon (Dr.)
3. " Avila Emilio (Dr.)
4. " Bienvenido Sanchez
5. 1st Lt. Miranda P. de Anong (WAFAS)

He was discharged from the dispensary as an incapacitated patient on Nov. 14, 1943.

Further examination at this date of writing by the undersigned revealed that the first wound mentioned has already healed, but there is a sensation of numbness within a circumference of about 4 inches around the region of the scar. The second mentioned wound has already healed at the point where the bullet penetrated, but has not been dislodged and has been there since the time of injury.

Due to the fact that there has been no available facilities which could be used to extract the bullet, the undersigned deems it wise that before such operation be attempted, complete hospital facilities must be available.

It is therefore highly recommended that the said Capt. Leo. B. de Anong, who has been wounded in action be given as much as possible all medical care and attention inasmuch as there is

none at present available in the jurisdiction of this command.
