The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the "Bolemen Battalion", purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and tentimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons vantioned below:

a. Record of service was not substantiated as a combat unit by sufficient acceptable evidence. Collect

b. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the ender concert; Jut P. H. Burn

c. A definite military organization was not established.



- b. Record of service was not substantiated as a combat unit by sufficient acceptable evidence, all records show the members of Bolomen Battalion were used as laborers.
- c. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy, all persons interviewed stated that the members of the Bolomen Battalion performed duty as laborers for the 15th Infantry, USAFIP, NL.
- $\mbox{\bf d}.$  A definite military organization was not established. The organization was a labor unit.
- e. As a combat unit they did not show satisfactory continuity of activity. The records show they were used as laborers by the 15th Infantry USAFIP NL.
- f. The Military Mayor (Pedro L. Valentin) of Piddig said that orders in the unit file are original copies of orders ussued to the Bolomen Battalion (See unit file).
- g. No useful purpose will be served by any further investigation of this unit. There are no members worthy of recognition.

### 4. POLITICAL ASPECT:

This unit does not appear to have any political affiliations or aspirations.



It is recommended that the Bolomen Battalion be not favorably considered for recognition.

: THE COMMANDING GREERAL AFWESPAC, APO 707

l.As per official instruction of Col. Volckman, Commanding Officer of the 15th Inf. UBAFF, ML, ordering the Millary Hayor of Piddig, Ilocos Morta, the immediate organization of a Bolomen Battalion, said Battalion, was without hesitation, formed and mustered on Jan. 8, 1944 under the aus-pices of Mr. DOROTEO PANDARAGAN, now, the Executive Officer

the said outfit. 2. That because Mr. DOROTEO PANDARAGAN saw the need of hawing an experienced military man to be the Battalion Commander of maid organization, he ordered Hr. Clarencio Foronda, the Intelligence Officer, to contact MRT.Lieut. FRIMITIVO I. SALES. a BATAN-A-WRAFFE OFFICER TO assume the post. Mr. Fo-

ronda got the good offices of IST. Lieut. PRIMITIVO A. SAIRS the next day, and immediately, he was officially designated as the Battalion\_Commander of the organization.

1. That the functions and purposes of the organization are follows: (a) They helped and fought side by side with the Guer-

rillas in their mopping up operations against the Japanese.

(b) They acted as ammunition and weapon carriers of the Guerrillas. (c) They were instrumental in the maintenance of the Guerrillas quarters, and largely responsible for the gathering of food for their subsistence as well as furnishing them their

clothing necessities. (d) They acted as message carriers from one town another within the provinces of Ilocos Norte, Ilocos Sur, Abra

and La Union. (c) They acted as runners and patrols of the town.
(f) They took charge of the denolition and construc-

tion of bridges to suit the exigencies of the operations. (g) They were largely instrumental in the building and construction of the first Army Airfield in Northern Luzon after the Liberation, located at Santa Maria District of Piddig Ilocos Norte, and other military installations in the entire area liberated by the Guerrillas before the arrival of the AMERICAN liberated by the Gu This organization continuously rendered services up to and inclus-

ding May 15, 1945. 4. That although the official order from Col. Volckman came only on Jan. 5,1945, their organization (SOUGHEN BATALION) had been function since Sept. 28,1944, the date when the Guerrillas under the command of a certain Capt. Dona liberated and took charge of the town, which was thereby made their General HQ. . Attached herewith therefore, to support this organization are as follows:

#### HISTORY OF THE BOLOMEN BATTALION Piddig, Ilocos Norte

The town of Piddig is the remotest in the eastern part of Ilocos Norte. It is only a small town of about 13,000 inhabitants known for their agricultural self-sufficiency. It is in this particularly remote and self-sufficient town that the unconquered Gov. Roque Ablan held out and put up his last organized fight against the Japanese in the latter part of 1942, long after the fall of Corregidor. It is in this same town which in the middle of 1944, the 15th Infan-try, under Col. Volckman, began its systematic mopping up campaign against the Japanese in Northern Luzon.

In September 26, 1944, a detachment of about 50 poorly equipped guerillas of the 121 st Infantry under the able command of Capt. Dona, occupied the town, raised the American Flag and permanently quartered themselves therein. The proximity of the Japanese in the adjacent towns, and the small number of his men made it imperative on the part of the said captain to reinforce his strength one way or other. He ordered the immediate organization of a bolomen battalion. Upon such order, the late Lt. Antolin Asis, Bataan ex-USAFFE Officer, native of the town organized the battalion, the nucleus of which were composed of the other Bataan survivors and residents who had ROTC training in schools and colleges. Almost all able bodied men from the different barries of the town joined. The whole town was one and all for the defense of our beloved town whose safety was in peril any time.

It came to pass that more men under the command of Capt. John P. O'Day, also of the 121st Infantry, joined those that were already in the town. They numbered now about 200 and maintenance became suddenly a question. The belomen battalion was given the responsibility of furnishing quarters, food, clething, and all that. The town became a recruiting station and a vast military training camp. From the rank and file of our battalion many were inducted into the guerilla outfit being organized. The remaining members of the battalion now became permanently a separate unit and assigned the following duties:

(a) to patrol the outskirts of the town in all possible entries of the enemy, for 24 hours.

(b) to deliver messages to any town or province as the case may be.
(c) to blast bridges thay may cut off the enemy and

construct new ones at advantage.

(d) to have sufficient men ready at a moment's no-tice to carry ammunitions and supplies or to go the field of operations as reserve manpower, or to serve the Army in any capacity deemed expedient for the success of the operations.

All these duties were accomplished by our bolomen battalion.

When Capt. Joe of the Advance Reconnoissance Intelligence Party landed with his men in Bangui, Ilocos Norte, from Australia, it was our bolo battalion that hauled the arms and ammunitions that they landed to be distributed to the guerillas in our town. This was in the middle of October, 1944.

With improved equipment and manpower close to 1,000, the guerillas began a series of attacks against the Japanese attained in the neighboring towns. In all these campaigns the members of our belomen battalion joined too. To every armed soldier two belomen were assigned in their post in the field of battle. The purpose seemed to be that should the armed soldier fall during action, a beloman would be ready to hold his rifle and continue the fight actively. In these operations some of our men died.

The surprise attack of the Japanese against the guerillas in Piddig, Ilocos Norte in the early dawn of December 4, 1944 will roll down to history, wherein the belomen of that town, with spears and belos sprang from out of the dawlmess and grappled hand to hand with the enemy before they could begin firing. The guerilla unit then stationed in that town could have been wiped out in that tatack, and plenty of heavy new ammunition could have oeen captured if it were not for the belomen who swarmed like ants to hack the Japanese. The guerilla were, before daybreak, able to withdraw to a safe hide-out in the mountains before the enemy was able to do any harm. In this struggle many of our belomen perised plenty of Japanese. The Japanese left the town in ashes the following morning, and over the sehes our belomen built provisional quareters for the guerilla in no time.

Campaigns after campaign against the Japanese continued in far towns and provinces, like Ilocos Sur, Abra and the Mountain provinces. The situation of our beloman did not change. The carried food and supplies, ammunitions to whereever the Infantry was. He remained the cook, the caterer and the bashboy. He fired a gun when the situation when the situation so demanded. He remained the laborer or the carpender wherever there was work for the Army.

Not long after the landing of the AMERICAN LIBERATION FORCES at Leyte, a secret airfield was built and constructed in the district of Santa Maria, Piddig, Ilocos Norte. The boloman was the builder. This afficial is so important in the operations in Northern Luson, it being the first airfield available wherein supplies and ammanitions could be landed to our forces, who at that time were yet cut from main supply lines by the enemy. Aside from this airfield, our bolomen were the first ones to help the Americans reconstruct the Gabu Airfield, Laceg, Ilocos Norte.

The efficial order from Col. Volckman to organize the bolomen battalion came only en or about Jan. 8, 1945, when it was already an organization functioning, and have been rendering services since October 28, 1944.

The Bolomon Battalion of Fiddig, Ilocos Norte ceased to exist actively in the last days of May, 1945, when there was no longer much resistance from the Japanese.
