Dear Mr. Tofalla:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the "Tafalla Unit, IX Corps. PGOS." purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for generalia recognition, established by General Memarkur during the liberation of the Philippinas, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this generalia unit is not deemed to be warrented because of reasons mentioned below.

- a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable
- b. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.
- activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.
- Adequate records were not maintained (names, ranks, dates of enlistment or joining, dates of promotions, and necessary related information).
- e. Sphere of operations and unit strength claimed by the unit were not commensurate with the nature of the terrain, limitation of community in the community of the strength of the community of the crea during the period concerned.
- $t \ge t^2$ planting of the unit did not devote their entire effort to militaring systims in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and framing obligations.
- It is considered that the previous recognition of three (3) men from the Taralla Unit. II Corps. PACG, who were recognized under Company

Report on "Tafalla Unit, II Corps, P.Q.O.G., Bailen, Cavite"

- 1. 1st Lts Charles L. Homewood and Lester Pierce, Jr., proceeded to Bailan, Gavite, on 29 January 1947 to investigate the Tafalla Unit, II Corps. P.80.G.
 - 2. ALLEGED HISTORY: (See attached Unit File)
 - 3. FINDINGS:
- a. The following persons were interviewed and their statements reflected in the findings:

Vicente Umali, CO, I Corps, PQOE Benedicto Valenzons, CO, II Corps, PQOE P. Figueroa, Capt, MFC (PA) Lino V. Salazar, Col, CO, Spark Regt Caster Dominguez, Capt, Spark Regt Primitvo San Aguetin, Col, (FA) Nicolas Tafalla, Lt Col, Tafalla Unit Natalio Tafalla, Lt Col, Tafalla Unit Luis Dimapiles, Cad Lt., Tafalla Unit Julian Ubaldo, let Sgt, Tafalla Unit Dominador Lopez, Sgt, Tafalla Unit

- b. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. This organization under the command of recognized 2nd Lieut. Natalio Tefalla, was expected comprised of members of the Spark Regt, who were conditted from the screened roster of this regiment. This screened roster was recognized as the first (Felimiano) En, with a strength of 272, When the Commanding Officer was requested to present records of the unit, he stated the unit had none, because they had been members of the Spark Rest.
- c. The unit was not maintained satisfactor.ly in the field in opposition to the enemy. The Commanding Officer stated that the members of the unit had lived at home and were called upon when supplies were needed by the Spark Regiment. No attachment claimed, with the exception of the three (3) recognized members.
- d. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy. The Commanding Officer stated that they had no contact with the enemy, prior to the landing of the liberating forces, then only three men of this unit were attached to American Forces because the rest had no weapons. The three men were attached with Go "B", lst [Fellmiano] Bm, 55th Division.
- e. Adequate records were not maintained. When the investigating team asked for the unit's records they were unable to present any, and revealed the fact that the unit had none.

- f. Sphere of operations and unit strength claimed by the unit were not commensurate with the nature of the terrain, limitations of communication facilities, and the degree of anti-resistance activities of the Japanese in the area during the period concerned. The unit claims the burning of the Free Frees building and the blasting of bridges and railway in Barrio San Jacinto, Victoria, Tarlac, which the Commanding Officer admitted was the work of one officer prior to the time he joined the unit,
- g. Members of the unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations. It was stated by the Gommanding Officer that members of
- h. No useful purpose will be served by further investigation of this unit. There are no members of this unit worthy of recognition.

4. POLITICAL ASPECTS:

This unit does not appear to have any political affiliations or aspirations.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS:

It is recommended that, with the exception of those 3 members previously recognized, the Tafalla Unit, II Corps, PQOG, be not favorably considered for recognition.

- c. That Lt. vel. Tafalla and Tafalla's unit helped the liberation of the towns of Luatinlupa, slateng, Sukat, Las Fihas all of the Freyings of Mizzl; and the towns of Aliense and ternate of the Prevince of Cavite.

BRIDE HISTORY

On November 15, 1942, this unit was organized. These men took oath under my command. With most of these men several arms were taken from Bataan under great risk and danger from the enemy. Continued resistance against the chemy was exhibited by this unit.

On the early part of October 1944, the same unit was incorporated in the P. Q. O. G. under Ohl. Vicente Umali and Col. Frimitivo San Agustin through the work of Col. Luansing.

This company, under Captain Natalio Tafalla is part of the 55th Infantry Regiment, P. Q. O. G. Most of their activities were fighting many stragglers, sabbotage and intelligence work.

That said Lt. Colonel Tafalla is a commissioned officer of the Philipoine Army inducted into the USAFTE and have seen action in Battan;

That in view of Lt. Col. Tafalla's military background, he was instrumental in effecting discipline, training and character of the PQOS command:

That Lt. Col. Tafalla initiated the first fight against the enemy in the province of Cavite four days before the landing of the American forces in Nasugbu, Batangas;

That Lt. Col. Tafalla commanded our unit in the liberation of Muntinlupa, Alabang, Sukat, Las Pinas, all of Rizal Province and && the towns of Calamba, and Cabuyao of the province of Laguna and the towns of Ternate, and Alfoneo all of Cavite province;

That Lt. Col. Tafalla was the executive officer of one of the companies officially attached to the 11th Airborne Division of our unit.
