The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the 5th Regiment, 5th Infantry Division (PQOG), purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, has not been favorably considered for recognition.

It is felt that the recognition extended to personnel of the POOC General Headquarters and of the 2nd Infantry Regiment, President Quezon's Own Guerrillas (PQOG), a composite unit from the overall command, constitutes just and adequate acknowledgement of military service.

This decision does not preclude individual request for casualty recognition by injured personnel or their heirs. request from interested individuals, appropriate casualty forms will be forwarded.
