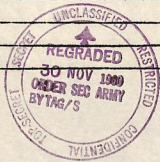

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the Cayacas Regiment (PQOG), purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, has not been favorably considered for recognition.

It is felt that the recognition extended to personnel of the PQOG General Headquarters and of the 2nd Infantry Regiment, President Quezon's Own Guerrillas (PQOG), a composite unit from the overall command, constitutes just and adequate acknowledgement of military service.

This decision does not preclude individual request for casualty recognition by injured personnel or their heirs. Upon request from interested individuals, appropriate casualty forms will be forwarded.

Subject: Report on Accomplishment, Cayacas Troops

To : Commanding Officer, C.I.C. Office  
San Pablo City

1. I have the honor to report on the accomplishment of this Command in connection with the present campaign against the scattered Japs in the Barrio of San Isidro of this City.

2. On August 3, 1945, at about two (2:00) O'clock, Capt. Federico Romo, with Pvts. Isabelo Pansoy, Serio Pansoy, Severino Pansoy, Pedro Katigbac, Pablo Banayo, and Engracio Beron were patrolling the vicinities of the Barrio San Isidro, report was recieved that there was a fight between the Japs and our brothers in the nearby sector.

3. Our men rushed to the place and help them fight against the Japs, and after for a short time exchange of shots, they wese able to found ten (10) Japs killed, and returned to their camp.

4. Early the next morning our men were scouting in the battled area they saw one (1) Japs sitting under a coconut tree, our men fired the Japs and killed.

5. Approaching the dead bodies of the (11) Japs soldiers, they found wese able to get the following:

- (a) 7 Japs rifles
- (b) 2 Japs sabbers
- (c) 1 Map

6. All personal effects were subaltted except the Japs rifle and sabber which taken by the other Unit who was first to come before us to be use in thier outfit.

S i r :

I have the honor to submit the following report on our accomplishment in connection with the present campaign against the scattered japs in the Outh San Pablo sector:

On May 24, 1945, a group of soldiers under this Command headed by Sgt. Alfonso Aguila while on patrol duties along the Gugulmen Creek at Santisimo Rosario, this City, encountered several japs, the exact number of which, as not definitely determined.

When our men sighted the japs within firing distance, Capt. Aguila gave the order to fire. Judging from the hurried movements starting from the jap side, we deduced that a number of them escaped in confusion.

Upon reaching the spot where we directed our first shots, we found three (3) dead japs, one of whom was still moving hands in vain. We tried to revive him but to no avail.

THE MATTER OF ALLOWANCES:

Aside from your probable DOLLAR PAY; the following allowances are hereby allotted, effective October 15, 1944:

1. For non-commissioned officers and enlisted men in the active service -----\$500.00mo.
2. For Commissioned Officers up to the rank of Captain in the active service-----\$1,000.00mo.
3. For Majors in the active service-----\$2,000.00mo.
4. For Lt.-Cols. and Cols. in the active service-----\$5,000.00mo.
5. For Brig. Gens. up, in the active service--\$10,000.00

For every dependent over than one of all officers and men in the active service an additional allowance of \$300.00 monthly is hereby ordered.

All officers and men in the active service are allowed free food and if possible free clothing.

Pay days shall be on the 15th and the 30th of every month.

Proper payrolls to be signed by the persons drawing their allowances should be kept by the respective G-4's or S-4's, as the case may be

THE MATTER OF FIREARMS:

All firearms and ammunition used by the officers and men of the PQOG should be properly licensed by their Division Commanders, and a proper record thereof submitted to higher Headquarters.

Only officers and men in the active service are permitted to possess and hold firearms.

Beginning October 15, 1944 all firearms should be properly licensed.

Beginning November 15, 1944, all firearms without license are liable to confiscation.

Regimental, Division, and Corp Staffs, are responsible for the carrying out of this order; that is to say if any officer or men under them carries a firearm without license, they are the ones who will be primarily subjected to disciplinary action.

Members of the Regiments, Division, Corps, and Army Staffs and their corresponding guards, as well as the "COMBATANTS IN THE FIELD" are authorized to confiscate unlicensed firearms; and any action on this matter should be reported immediately to their superior officers.

Regimental Commanders up may be allowed to hold and possess firearms in Reserve upon approval and permission of the Army Commander.

All firearms belonging to the PQOG are hereby ordered disposed of as follows, before the zero-hour:

1. Members of the Army, Corps, Division, Regimental Guards are authorized two pistols or revolvers each; their assistants, one each.

2. Members of the Army, Corps, Division, and Regimental Guards are authorized to possess and hold rifles, auto-rifles, garands, sub-machine guns, carbines, and all other types of small infantry weapons, one for each man, while the Guard Commanders are allowed a side arm each.

B- Duties of each Unit:

1. The Platoon S-1 keeps the papers and records of the platoon, disseminates the circulars and orders issued by higher headquarters, serves as guides, and medical first aiders.
2. The Platoon S-2 are the eyes and ears of the organization in the locality, getting all information that has some bearing with our work, with the enemy moves, fortifications, and inter-organizational news. Serves as the first vanguard in the protection of the organization from traitors and spies by keeping those suspected people under observation and taking the required steps.
3. The Platoon S-3 is the Combatants of the Platoon, who will concentrate on training in extended order drill, musketry, marksmanship, and in acquainting themselves with the terrain of the barrio. Before entering active service they will be used as rondes or civilian guards by those in the active service.
4. The Platoon S-4 collects, gathers, stores, keeps, and systematizes all the food supplies and other property of the organization gathered from the local sources or store therein; and in some instances will be the platoon k.p.

In a barrio, there are three or more platoons, Capt and their respective company staffs may be created and commissioned as an intermediary command unit with that of the Regimental Staff and the local units; but simplicity and directness of organization is always advised.

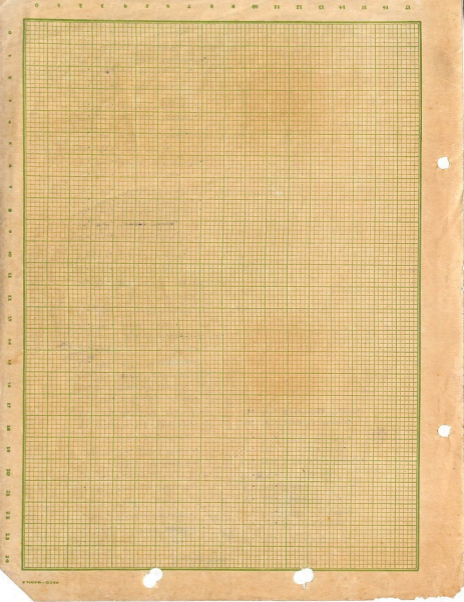
