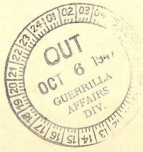

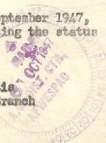

1. The "Medical Service Battalion, McKinley Division," a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, has not been favorably considered for recognition by this headquarters.
2. This decision is based on the results of a careful investigation by this headquarters. The important factors brought out by this investigation are as follows: (1) The unit did not actively resist the Japanese forces, and (2) Members of the unit were performing their regular duties as government employees during the enemy occupation.
3. Your attention is invited to Presidential Executive Order, Number 68, Commonwealth of the Philippines, copy of which is attached. You are requested to comply with the provisions of the above mentioned order.

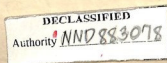

ACTIVITIES

The Medical Corps of the McKinley Brigade were those that worked in the Emergency Hospital, situated in the compounds of the National Psychopathic Hospital. This hospital was created by the Bureau of Health with the knowledge of the late Director of Health Dr. E. Aguilar. The hospital was maintained also for the guerrillas who came down from the mountains, considered as civilian patients, besides those service men who came from Capas, Tarlac. The hospital was kept open thru the Japanese regime, until it was taken over by FCAU No. 1 when the Americans came. Under this FCAU this hospital became a special hospital wherein war casualties in the battle of Manila were admitted.

Since its foundation up to its transfer under FCAU No. 1 this hospital took care of 2119 patients, among which are about 500 guerrillas and the rest Capas ex-servicemen.

We were able to take care of 26 civilian Americans.

We were able to bring to the mountains thru our carriers medical supplies, such as iodine, lysol, gauze, bandages, plasters, etc. besides 50,000 quinine tablets. The quinine tablets were sent in small amounts for about one year. The collection of these medicines was with the knowledge of the late Director of Health.

Our members report regularly the activities of the Japanese soldiers and officers at the nearby garrison. Our members cut the communication lines of this garrison on two occasions, when the Americans were already at Lingayen. Our members typewrote and distributed short-wave radio news daily, from San Francisco, New Delhi and Australia, an act that meant death those days.

Many of our nurses and aiders worked without compensation at the Marikina Camp of the McKinley Brigade, last May, 1945.

The members of this Corps have always given contributions in various amounts to maintain those in the mountains. Some have given clothes and shoes. Our carriers could not go to the mountains for no less than TWO HUNDRED PESOS (P200.00), and these expenses, we always defrayed.

ACTIVITIES

The Medical Corps of the McKinley Brigade were those that worked in the Emergency Hospital, situated in the compounds of the National Psychopathic Hospital. This hospital was created by the Bureau of Health with the knowledge of the late Director of Health Dr. E. Aguilar. The hospital was maintained also for the guerrillas who came down from the mountains, considered as civilian patients, besides those service men who came from Capas, Tarlac. The hospital was kept open thru the Japanese regime, until it was taken over by PCAU No. 1 when the Americans came. Under this PCAU this hospital became a special hospital wherein war casualties in the battle of Manila were admitted.

When the Capas servicemen were taken there, we had more than one thousand patients, besides guerrilla cases. The numbers went down as patients were discharged, but we kept the hospital constantly open.

Besides taking care of patients, we were able to send quinine tablets to the mountains thru our carriers. The medicine ~~was~~ sent with the knowledge of the late Director of Health.

The members of this Corps ^{gave} always given contributions in various amounts to maintain those in the mountains. Some have given clothes and shoes. Our carriers could not go to the mountains for no less than TWO HUNDRED PESOS (P200.00), and these expenses, we always defrayed.
