2. BASIS FOR NOW\_RECOGNITION:

a. The following is a remark of Col. Fertig, "The service in the home guards was purely voluntary without pay or recognition other than a diploma for having served as a Wolunteer guard. While on duty they were expected to do whatever task was assigned to them. The tasks normally assigned to the terming of the approvant of the energy, and to carry cargo". An additional comment by Fertig states, "It is recommended that the request for the recognition of the home guards be disapproved."

b. This unit has no legitimate claims for recognition since the duties listed above cannot be construed as those of a combat military unit.
