Dear Mr. Alviseo,

The Liang Guerrilla Organization, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, has not been favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all available substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

- a. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy, during the occupation.
- b. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.
- c. A definite organization was not established.
- d. Record of service was not established by sufficient acceptable evidence.

It is requested that you comply with the provisions of Executive Order No. 68, by the President of the Philippines, dated 26 September 1945, copy attached.

Sir:

In my capacity as a guerrilla leader and organizer of the "Lianga Guerrilla Organization" was organized for the purpose of protecting the lives, properties and rights of the civilians against the massacre of our common enemy, I have the honor to apply for the recognition of our Guerrilla being an Independent from the rest of the organized of Mindanao guerrillas. Aside from this our guerrilla enlisted men fought against the Japanese forces and some died for our common cause. No members surrendered instead they fought to kill our common enemy.


After the reorganization of the guerrillas organized within the limit of Mindanao, my men were joined to the 10th Military District, and myself was connected to the Quartermaster Service under the 107th Division, 10th Military District, until the Japanese forces invaded Lianga. As to my pertinent papers relative to my organization I am sending them thru separate envelope.

Herewith attached the Roster Of Troops who joined from Jan. 15, 1943 up to June 30th, 1943 that was the time that all guerrillas at Mindanao were reorganized. However, there are those who joined in other months which will be sent in my other communication.

In this connection, I would therefore request that office that as to the references of my organization all pertinent papers referred to in this communication will be sent for your full information concerning the activities made by this organization.
