Its existence is deemed important by the undereigned in as much as this place is within the vicinity of the enemy. The part that will be played by this organization will be realized with the ennumeration of its duties.
- 2. In the first place, it serves as a First Aid Unit. The members are trained to give first aid to wounded soldiers. In the field they are trained to pitch their own tents were they take wounded and bleeding soldiers when hospitals are very far away. They do the work of men where men are not available. In this unit where encounter of the enemy is filways expected, the organization of the said WAS is therefore important.
- 3. In the second place, this organization will be of great help to the soldiers now sick in our camp.
- 4. And in the third place, it would be of help in many ways, like taking care of the clothes, mending and cooking.
- 5. Being the Medical Inspector of this Unit, I deem it myduty to organize the said WAS with the full cooperation of all officers of this Unit.

That I was formerly a Lt. Colonel, Philippine Army, and that upon my request, I was released from the service on January 21, 1946;

That I was formerly the Adjutant General and Chief of Staff of the Negros Island Guerrilla Forze organized sometime in September, 1942:

That on orders from headquarters of the Negros Island Guerrilla Force, the Women' Auxilliary Service of Bais, Negros Oriental (later the Women Auxilliary Corps) was organized under the command of Mrs. Remedios Z. Mendoza, who was designated as the Commanding Officer of the organization and given the rank of CAPTAIN;

That said Women Auxilliary Corps was performing the duties of an auxilliary Unit to our personnel, such as first aid, cooking, mending, tailoring and hospitalization and care of the sick soldiers and officers;

That the personnel of the Negros Island Guerrilla Force were assimilated into the Seventh Military District on November 25, 1943 and were assigned to the 77th Infantry (7MD);

That the said Women Auxilliary Corps continued to serve the personnel of the 77th Infantry, 7th Military District until the liberation period;

That some of the papers pertinent to the organization of the Women Auxilliary Corps of Bais referred to herein were lost during the mopping up operations by the Enemy.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto affixed my signature this 25th day of February, 1948, at Manjuyod, Negros Oriental, Philippines.
