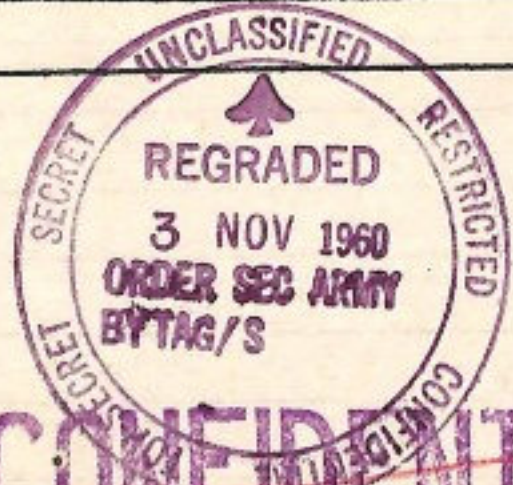

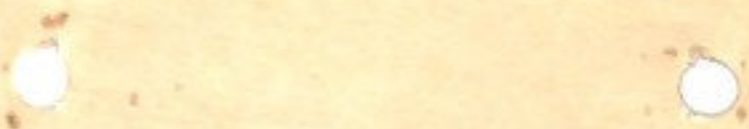

S i r :

I received your communication dated 11 October 1947 in answer to my letter dated 29 September 1947 requesting the status of the ECLGA Unit, Bacoor, Cavite.

As stated in your honorable answer, a thorough search of your files failed to reveal any record of this unit. It is indeed a great surprise to me for for when I went up there on the 29th of April 1947, I had a personal talk with Lt. Col. Ramsey and through him, I was introduced to Capt. Fernando, incharge of the Records Section of the Guerrilla Affairs Division, whereby Capt. Fernando courteously attended me and exerted his efforts to locate among all his cards, the card pertaining to our unit. It was then found out that this unit had no card whereby said Capt. Fernando looked over the files of the unrecognized units in his shelves. Finally, Capt. Fernando located the roster inside a big envelope which was presented by me and Major Mariano Martin, our commanding officer of the said unit to Lt. Col. Shaptoe and Lt. Col. Carnahan, the then officers incharge of the Guerrilla Affairs. Upon opening of the said envelope by Capt. Fernando, the undersigned was questioned as to the papers inside the envelope whereby the undersigned had given a satisfactory answer. Capt. Fernando himself told the undersigned that it was just a matter of time and a little more patience before the matter will be taken up.

Capt Fernando was never in charge of records.

I therefore request your honor, if it is not asking you too much, to kindly refer this letter of mine to Capt. Fernando if he is still incharge of the Records Section of your headquarters, for i do believe that by showing him this letter, he will remember me.

In view of the fact that i am tied up in my work, I am delegating Captain (Atty) I. Crisostomo of Bacoor, Cavite, to come over to your office personally to investigate the whereabouts of our unit's roster and if my presence there, is still needed, i will exert all my efforts to appear personally before you for an interview for the benefit of the forgotten members of the ECLGA Unit, Bacoor, Cavite.

Your honor Sir:

In accordance with your publication at the Manila Sunday Times 28 September 1947, putting the deadline on 31 December 1947 for guerrillas, I wish to inform you that the ECLGA Unit of Bacoor, Cavite, under Col. Ramsey, had been in your office of the guerrilla affairs since 9 June 1946 and until now we are only in the words of promise to wait.

This roster had been received from us by Lt. Col. Shaptoe and Lt. Col. Carnahan since 9 June 1946 and was told that we will be informed of the date of contact. Everytime that we went to the Office of the Guerrilla Affairs same promise to wait was all our answer.

Last April 29, 1947, I personally went again and had a personal talk with Captain Fernando of the Guerrilla Affairs and our roster was shown to me and was told that it won't be long that our case will be handled.

"Now comes this deadline."

I therefore humbly request your honor, in the name of the Three Hundred eleven (311) officers and enlisted men of the above mentioned unit as Executive Officer under the rank of captain as can be noted in our official roster if there is any hope or any defect in our case. As far as our address is concerned, the address given in our envelope and official roster is just the same except myself in view of my service in the U. S. Navy, which I am here as Chief of the Base Police, of the U. S. Naval Operating Base, Subic Bay, I remain

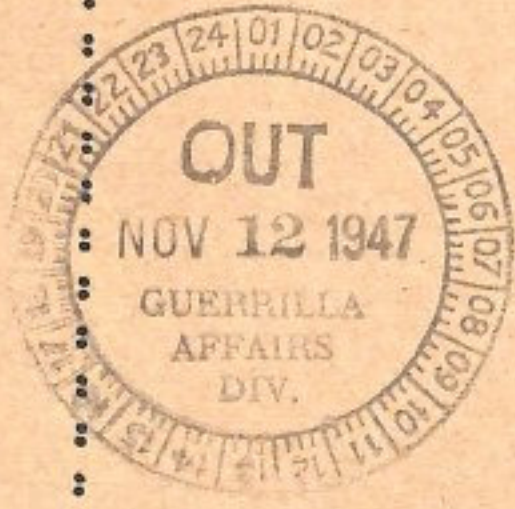
