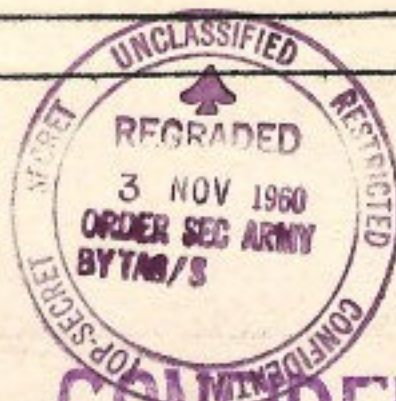

Dear Mr. Sebastian:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the 1st Zaragoza Guerrilla Company, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

- a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.
- b. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.
- c. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.
- d. A definite organization was not established.
- e. Adequate records were not maintained (names, ranks, dates of enlistment or joining, dates of promotions, and necessary related information).
- f. Rank of members was considered to be too high for the actual size of the command maintained in the field.
- g. Some personnel listed as members of the unit assisted it by contributing money and supplies but did not serve in a capacity considered to justify such membership.

This decision on the proposed unit roster does not preclude submission for the individual and casualty recognition by those individuals who are qualified and feel justified in entering such claims. Upon

TEAM LEADER'S REPORT

REPORT ON THE "1st ZARAGOSA GUERRILLA COMPANY"

1. On 14 February 1947, Captain C. G. Fernando, examined the request for recognition of the 1st Zaragosa Guerrilla Company.

2. ALLEGED HISTORY: (See attached Request for Recognition)

3. FINDINGS:

a. After a careful examination of the unit's request for recognition it was deemed that a field investigation is not necessary.

b. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. No evidence was submitted to substantiate the alleged existence of the unit during the Japanese Occupation or Liberation. No documentary evidence of any nature was submitted with the request to establish the presumption of an organized resistance against the enemy.

c. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy. No evidence was submitted to establish active resistance against the enemy. No proof of circumstances was submitted to support the claim that the alleged casualties sustained by the unit were results of actual combat with the enemy.

d. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy. Activities of the unit were of a passive and apparently overt nature. Alleged activities cited by the Commanding Officer consisted of help to friendly guerrilla units such as contributions of money, food and supplies and in protecting and aiding civilians in the locality.

e. A definite organization was not established. The only record submitted by the unit was a non-standard roster. Ranks listed are too high and are not commensurate with the strength of the unit.

f. No useful purpose will be served by further investigation of this unit. No members are worthy of recognition and alleged casualties are included in the roster.

4. POLITICAL ASPECTS:

This unit does not appear to have any political affiliations or aspirations.

5. RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the 1st Zaragosa Guerrilla Company be not favorably considered for recognition.

Request that the 1st. Zaragoza Guerilla Company be recognized with the following reasons:

1. That the 1st. Zaragoza Guerilla Company was organized 13 August 1942, through the initiative of the undersigned then an escaped prisoner of war with the sole purpose of continuous resistance against the enemy.

2. That the said unit was officially activated 6 March 1943, following the taking of oath of officers and enlistedmen before Lt. Col. Pacifico Briones, (deceased) then Commanding Officer of the General Service Troop, East Central Luzon Guerilla Force, (Ramsey Guerilla) at Sta. Barbara, San Antonio, Nueva Ecija.

3. That the said unit was detached from the main body upon the order of Lt. Col. Briones, on or before 22 December 1944, due to the inadequate number of fire arms for use of the company. However, although detached from the main body, the 1st Zaragoza Co. continued the act of resistance by cooperating and by furnishing other guerilla units in the form of food supplies and informations leading to the successful crushing of enemy units that pass through Tarlac, Cabanatuan road.

4. That the 1st Zaragoza Co. was automatically disbanded when the undersigned, then Commanding Officer of the said unit reported to military control to the 2nd. Replacement Bn. at Calasiao, Pangasinan, on 9 Feb. 1945.

5. Important activities and accomplishment of the unit during its existence, are as follows:

a.

a. Contribution of P1,000 for the purpose of purchasing firearms and ammunitions.

b. Supplying of food, cigars and cigarettes for the consumption of the men of the main body of the General Service Troops, (ECLGF) and other guerilla units active in the vicinity of Zaragoza, Nueva Ecija.

c. Rounding up of suspected enemy spies and preventing their activities against our friendly guerilla units.

d. Posting of our own spies to work and gather valuable informations for the good of our friendly guerilla units.



(Company "M")

That the Company "M" was organized on 13 June 1942, through the initiative of the undersigned, who was then an escape Prisoner of War, with the sole purpose of continuing resistance against the enemy.

That the said unit was officially activated on 6 March 1943, following the taking of oath of officers and enlisted men before Lt. Col Pacifico Briones, (deceased) Commanding Officer of the General Service Troop, East Central Luzon Guerrilla Force, under the command of Edwin P. Ramsey, at Santa Barbara, Nueva Ecija.

That the said unit was detached from the main body upon order of Lt. Col. Briones, on or about December 22, 1944, due to the inadequate number of arms for the use of the said company, however, although detached from the main body the said company continued the act of resistance against the enemy by furnishing to the other guerrilla units in the forms of food and informations leading to the successful attack against the enemy that passed through the Tarlac, Cabanatuan Road by our friendly troops.

That the important activities and accomplishments of the said unit during the Japanese Occupation are as follows:

- a. Contribution amounting to ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) for the purpose of purchasing arms and ammunitions.
- b. Supplying food, cigars, and cigarettes for the consumption of the main body of the General Service Troop, (ECLGF) and other guerrilla units active in the vicinity of Zaragoza, Nueva Ecija.
- c. Rounding up of suspected enemy spies and preventing them of their activities against our friendly guerrilla units.
- d. Posting of spies to work and gather valuable informations for the good of our resistance.
- e. Protecting and aiding Evacuees from Manila and from other localities.

Operation Participated by the Unit:

On December 19, 1942, combined with the forces, Briones &

Fajardo Units, under the overall command of Lt. Col. Pacifico Briones, fought against a battalion or more of Japanese Soldiers, along the Chico River, south of Zaragoza, Nueva Ecija.



b. Pvt. Lucio Manlanlan - Killed in the massacre at Zaragoza, Nueva Ecija, on 21 December 1942, while gathering informations for our guerrilla units during the encounter against the Japanese Forces.


c. Cpl. Nestorio Salasak - Missing since 20 August 1943.




