I am submitting you a secret complaint pertaining to the affair of all Guerrillas in the Philippines who are entitled subject to benefits which they sacrificed during their resistance against the Japanese Army Occupation in the Philippines. This is applied to all the unit in Zamboanga. All officers assigned to this party are making money to the guerrillas I request to remove & replace this officer.

Also and officer not high in rank got rich quick assigned to certain depot in Manila during American Occupation. He was demobilized months ago and got married. The ceremony celebrated cost to \$10,000. At present he owns a beautiful jeep and two weapon carrier. Everything he use are all army stuffs. He is insured for P 20,000 besides

Dear Sir:

As a humble citizen imbued with an abiding faith in the integrity and justice of your administration, I respectfully bring to your attention the discrimination and injustices that are committed and will be committed if no remedy is made by the so called guerrillas. There are so many men who are included and wanted recognition although they were not really guerrillas.

A concrete example is the unit headed by Major Jose Aquino of Nueva Ecija. In his roster you will find names of men who did not take active part in any guerrilla activity but you will find them in the roster. This is done on condition that a certain percentage ^{of the back pay} will go to the higher officers who enlisted them. In

most it is business. They even go to the extreme of bribing the personnel of the Army headquarters. This did not work because the headquarters want advance payment, the guerrillas especially the officers who made the transactions want to give the bribe amounting to several thousands of pesos after they have collected the back pay.

So Lt. General W. D. Styer, you must be as wise as a serpent. You must give back pay only to those who really joined the army, who fought for our country, and to the widows and orphans and not to those who claim they are members of this and that guerrilla unit. ~~There is no question~~

I would suggest that only those guerrillas who joined America when they landed in the Philippines be given back pay, or those who are actually serving the army be processed. You must be very strict. Drill these men before giving their back pay.
