

1. The unit listed below is recognized by the Commanding General, United States Army Forces, Western Pacific, as having been an authorized element of the Philippine Army, inducted into the Armed Forces of the United States from 7 April 1945 to 25 August 1945:

Company G. Sta Cruz Sector, Magsaysay's Forces, ZMD

2. Under the provisions of Executive Order No 21, by the President of the Commonwealth of the Philippines, dated 28 October 1944, the status of the members of this unit, during the period above specified, was that of officers and enlisted men of the Philippine Army.

3. Under the provisions of Executive Order No. 68, by the President of the Commonwealth of the Philippines, dated 26 September 1945, all officers and enlisted men of this unit, other than those who are members of the Regular Force or the Reserve Force of the Philippine Army, will be considered as having been discharged from the Philippine Army as of 25 August 45.

#### ALLEGED HISTORY

The following history is actually a report of the Malona Sector since all members of Company G. Sta Grum Sector are from Malona and were formerly a part of the Malona Sector. The unit is in inc way connected with the Sta Grum Sector.

In October 1944 when news reports of American Suny progress reached Marrill he gave orders for units to harman the Impuness and to fire on then outside the barrics and towns.

After the landing of the American Perces 29 January 1945 in Paugardinian the Japs retreated South toward Malona and were there contested by part of the Malona Sector. Parts of the unit beates extended to the 151st Limitary in Reledam, while other numbers of Malona Sector were esseigned their areas for partolling.

Then the 595th Signal Aircraft Warning Buttalion returned to Sia Cruz Zumbales they took with them I officer and forty sight (50) emilsted and from the Milozon Sector and used them as security guards at 50s drum for the 15th Reporting Flatton, Company, C, 595th Signal Aircraft Warning Buttalion from 7 April 1955 until 25 August 1954 of which them the man were released from duty.

Except for their attachment to the above named unit, the Company, G. Sta Cruz Scotor, was not active as a military unit, either before or after the American Landings on Lumen.

Upon investigation it was found that, according to letter of certification signed by 1st Lieutenant Cerl F. Kohl, of the 595th Signal AW Bn, Company G, Sta Cruz Sector, Squadron A, Magsaysay's Guerrilla Forces, Zambeles Military District consisting of 1 officer and forty - eight (48) enlisted men was attached as a security guard to the 15th Reporting Platoon, Company "C" 595th Signal Aircraft Warning Battalion from 7 April 1945 to 25 August 1945.

Although members of subject unit are from Maloma and were formerly part of the Maloma Sector they went with the 595th Signal AW Bn to Sta Cruz and remained on duty with that unit until disbanded.

When 1st Lieutenant Carl F. Kohl made letter of attachment he referred to subject unit as Company G, Sta Cruz Sector, because that is where they were located.

It is believed that outside of the time Co G was attached to the 595th Signal Aircraft Warning Battalion at Sta Cruz for the period from 7 April to 25 August 1945, they were not actively engaged against the Japanese.



### POLITICAL ASPECTS

It is apparent that there were many aspirants to political jobs in this territory and numbers changed units frequently according to where ever the heat deal was promised.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

After careful consideration of the statements made by the present members and meakysis of the document presented, it is recommended that one (1) officer and forty edge; (1,0) emlisted zero on the rooter of coppany 0, for two Sectors, imagesque's Perces, Lambales Military Districts be frequently writing Pisteron, Coppany 70%, 595th Signal Aircraft Warning Bettalling for the percel form 7 April 135th to 5 America 1395.


