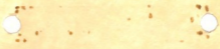

SUBJECT: Recognition of Guerrilla Units

TO : Chief of Staff, Philippine Army, APO 501.

1. Paragraph 1, letter, Headquarters, United States Army Forces, Pacific, File AG 770.64, subject: Recognition of Guerrilla Units, dated 22 October 1945 is amended to read as follows:

"The following guerrilla units are recognized by the Commander-in-Chief, United States Army Forces, Pacific, as having been authorized elements of this command from 4 February 1945 to 15 March 1945:

Magway's Guerrillas, Squadron D:	Approximate Strength
Medical Corps, San Marcelino Sector	66
Hq & Hq Company, San Marcelino Sector	107
Company "A", San Marcelino Sector	193
Company "D", San Marcelino Sector	193
Company "E", San Marcelino Sector	190
MP Company, San Marcelino Sector	135

2. The following paragraph is added to above mentioned letter:

"4. Under the provisions of Executive Order No. 68, by the President of the Commonwealth of the Philippines, dated 21 September 1945, all officers and enlisted men of this unit, other than those who are members of the regular army or the Reserve force of the Philippine Army, will be considered as having been discharged from the Philippine Army as of 16 March 1945."

**SUBJECT: Recognition of Pay And Sale Fees
And Selling War Materials Fees**

1. It is inferred that the following named men below have been selling war materials to the enemy (sabotees) during years 1943 and 44:

- 2nd Lt. Severino Manglicmot
- 2nd Lt. Arturo Manglicmot
- 1st Lt. Julian Ferrales

2. A part of this sabotees can be traced under the house of 2nd Lt. Severino Manglicmot, proprietor of said sabotees in said years above, at San Felipe, Zamboales.

3. Captain Jose Manglicmot, Sector Commander of San Felipe Sector was selling scrap items to the enemy during 1943 and 1944. He has gone as far as Palauig, Zamboales, buying said materials.

4. If they have been recognized Guerrillas and receiving pay from the Government of the United States and of the Government of the Philippines, I believe all those now under parol are entitled for pay as guerrillas.

5. Efraim Puloran of San Felipe, Zamboales can be asked about these matters, confidentially.
