NO INCONSISTENCY EXISTS IN OUR 693. SEE OUR NR 584 FOR SIGNIFICANCE OF TITLES WEEKLY REPORT. LAST WEEK WE RECEIVED 54 FLASH MESSAGES OF WHICH 42 WERE RELAYED TO NAVY. WE HAD 66 CONTACTS WITH OUTSIDE STATIONS DURING THE WEEK AS SHOWN UNDER "D" (CONTACTS AND CALL LETTERS OUTSIDE STATIONS). NOT ALL CONTACTS WITH OUTSIDE STATIONS ARE FLASH MESSAGES. 

With this shipment I believe that you have enough to keep you busy for a while. A large package of intelligence reports and maps which I consider extremely important to present operations was sent to you on the U. S. S. "Ray". After placing the package on this vessel, I received your signal advising me not to do so. As you know, the signal arrived after the vessel had left. However, I understand from Capt. Richmond that a transfer at sea is contemplated. I would appreciate your letting me know immediately when that package is received, and also when the packages accompanying this letter arrive as I will have occasion to refer to them in subsequent intelligence signals.

In future shipments, if any, I would appreciate receiving some arms. There are many sinkings around this island, and I figure that some day two or three thousand Japs might be dumped in my front yard as a result of same. As it now stands, I could not put up a very good fight with the arms presently at hand. Therefore, I would appreciate it if you could somehow arrange to let me have the following arms at your earliest convenience:

300 Carbines with Ammunition
50 Caliber .45 Revolvers with Ammo.
2 Caliber .30 Machine Guns with Ammo.
2 Bazukas with Ammo.

Should the subject of shipping space again arise, any part of the above will be appreciated.

If sufficient radios are received on this submarine, I intend to place them as follows:

Number 1 --- Mariveles Mt. in Bataan
Number 2 --- Lubang Island
Number 3 --- Just Outside of Balayan, Batangas
Number 4 --- Naujan
Number 5 --- Marinduque
Number 6 --- Maricaban Island
Number 7 --- San Jose
Number 8 --- Mamburao

In addition, Capt. Richmond will be given one radio for his work. The parties that will operate these sets have already been made up and will no doubt be in operation prior to your receipt of this letter. In advising you the whereabouts of these stations I will refer to them by the above numbers as they are set up. I regret that we were unable to establish this coverage prior to this time but I know that you realize the condition of my radio sets and batteries.

Major Ramsey of Manila is sending a great deal of intelligence through this station. I have supplied him with a radio and the network is working satisfactorily. I would appreciate it if you could do something for Ramsey as he has done and is doing an excellent job. Because of a lack of official supplies, however, he is losing "face" with his men. I have done my best to correct this deficiency by giving him small morale items. I know you will understand and will do everything possible to correct this uncalled for mistake in supply distribution among the Guerilla forces in Luzon.
