COL. WHITNEY;

THIS LETTER WILL SERVE AS A REPORT, AS TO CONDITIONS HERE AT BASE SECTION ONE, I AM PLEASED TO SAY, THAT EVERYTHING IS UNDER CONTROL.

THE MEN ARE STILL PULLING GUARD, ON THE AVERAGE OF ONCE EVERY TWELVE DAYS, THIS AFFECTS ONLY THE PVTS. AND PFC'S., THEY HAVE K.P. ONE DAY AND HAVE GUARD THREE OR FOUR DAYS LATER. I WILL KEEP YOU INFORMED, SIR, AS TO WHEN B.S.#1 EXPECTS THE DETACHMENT THAT IS TO TAKE OVER THE GUARD DUTIES HERE, NO ONE KNOWS YET WHEN THIS WILL BE.

I HAVE TAKEN IT UPON MYSELF, SIR, TO TRY AND TEACH MY MEN SOMETHING OF THE COMPONENT PARTS OF A RECEIVER AND TRANSMITTER, THIS IS NOT TO BE IN ANY WAY TECHNICAL, BUT DEALS STRICTLY WITH THE ACTION OF THE DIFFERENT CONTROLS UPON THE EQUIPMENT, AND WHAT THEY DO TO A SIGNAL FROM THE TIME IT IS PICKED UP, UNTIL THEY HEAR IT IN THE HEAD-SET, I AM LEAVING MATHEMATICS AND THE USE OF FORMULAS OUT OF IT ENTIRELY, IF THEY DECIDE TO GO DEEPER INTO THE SUBJECT, I WILL DO ALL I CAN TO HELP THEM.

AS YOU KNOW, SIR, I AM NOT AN OPERATOR, THIS PUTS ME IN A SPOT BECAUSE I AM NOT OF MUCH HELP TO THEM WHEN IT COMES TO CODE AND PROCEEDURE.

MAINTENANCE IS BEING DONE BY THE SECTION, ALTHOUGH I FIND THAT THEY DO NOT STOCK VERY MANY REPLACEMENTS, THEREFOR DUE TO THIS LACK OF PARTS, I HAVE TWO RECEIVERS OUT OF OPERATION DUE TO BURNT-OUT BOWER SUPPLIES, THIS DOES NOT IMPAIR THE OPERATION OF THIS STATION, BUT IT DOES LEAVE ME WITH NO STAND BY RECEIVER. IT WOULD BE OF GREAT VALUE, SIR, IF I COULD GET TWO OR THREE POWER SUPPLIES FOR HRO RECEIVERS, I COULD ADOPT THEM TO ALL THE SET HERE AT PRESENT.

WITH YOUR PREMISSION, SIR, I WOULD LIKE TO SEND YOU A FEW PICTURES OF THE RECEIVING ROOM AND THE GENERAL AREA, THIS WILL SHOW YOU, SIR, THE OPERATING CONDITIONS.

THE SPIRIT OF THE MEN IS HIGH AND THEY ARE ENJOYING THEIR WORK, THE HEAT GETS THEM DOWN AT TIMES, BUT THERE IS NO COMPLAINTS FROM THEM, I HAVE GOTTEN THEM A FEW GAMES, AND A SET OF HORSESHOES WITH WHICH THEY CAN WHILE AWAY THEIR LEISURE HOURS, AND I HAVE INSTALLED TWO ELECTRIC FANS WHICH DO COOL OFF THE OPERATING ROOM VERY MUCH.

THAT ABOUT COVERS EVERYTHING, SIR, I WILL KEEP YOU INFORMED OF ALL NEW DEVELOPEMENTS THAT CONCERNS OUR STATION.

Dear Baker:

1. In reference the several matters recently brought to my attention by you:

~~PERSONNEL~~ I can see why in any case our men might be expected to contribute a share in this work. You might study the feasibility of our sending up one or two men from the Headquarters and Headquarters Service Company just for such purpose. It is not my intention that your men shall have any duties other than those essential to develop desired efficiency in the radio station itself. Advise me further on this point after you have studied it.

~~STATUS~~ This is clearly beyond the scope of the orders assigning you to the base for "administration, rations, and quarters." I note that in your telegram on the subject suggestion was made that it was merely a temporary assignment. If the duty continues, please so advise me and I shall get special classification from (SEC) on the status of your detachment.

~~BASE STATION~~ The Chief Signal Officer expects to personally inspect the station about the end of the month with the view to working out a proper solution. I believe that the solution may be in new construction elsewhere, but believe you should carry on as and where you are, pending the arrival of General ALER.

2. I am having messages dispatched to our main Philippine contacts of which the following is a paraphrase:

"THE MORE CONTACTS ADVISE ALL FILIPINOS PAREN NICH KAE PAREN THAT THIS STATION IS NOW STAFFED BY FILIPINO OPERATORS AND, AS A CONSEQUENCE, THEIR SIGNALS ARE RECEIVED MORE BY THEIR OWN COUNTRYMEN. IN THIS RESPECTING TO FILIPINOS SO LARGE A SHARE OF THE RESPONSIBILITY IN THE MAINTENANCE OF HIS VITAL CHANNELS OF COMMUNICATIONS WITH THE PHILIPPINES, GENERAL MACARTHUR'S COMMITMENT IS A CHALLENGE TO HONORABLE FILIPINO EFFORT, HERE AND THERE AHEAD, WHERE MUST BE MET FULLY"

3. I wish that you would advise each member of your part of this action and see that he understands fully the importance of the mission of the group as a whole and the individual responsibility of each member.

DEAR SIR:

INFORMALLY I WISH TO BRING TO YOUR ATTENTION
THE DIFFICULTIES THAT HAVE ARISEN.

FIRST, THE ORDERS PLACING THIS PARTY ON D.T. IS NOT DEEMED
CLEAR AS TO THE FUNCTIONS OF THIS UNIT. I HAVE ENCLOSED THE ORDERS,
AND BASE SECTION ONE FEELS THAT THE MEN ARE OPEN FOR K.P., WHICH
CAUSES ILL FEELING INSOFAR AS THE OPERATORS ARE CONCERNED. I HAVE
BEEN ASSIGNED THE DUTY OF RADIO OFFICER FOR THE 12TH RADIO TEAM. AS
FOR THE LATTER, IT IS ONLY UNTIL AN OFFICER ARRIVES TO TAKE OVER SAID
DUTIES. ALSO, BASE SIGNAL OFFICER, CAPT. MILLER, IS PLANNING A NEW CON-
STRUCTION FOR BASE SIGNAL AND HE IS PLANNING ON KEEPING K.A.Z. IN
THE SAME AREA WITH THE OTHER SECTIONS. THIS ARRANGEMENT WILL ENLIGHTEN
THE REPAIR OF TRANSMITTERS, BUT WILL ALSO PLACE OUR OPERATIONS UNDER
THE CONTROL OF BASE ONE.

ALL OTHER THINGS ARE NORMAL AND THE OPERATORS THAT CAME
WITH ME ARE GETTING THE PROCEDURE AND I FEEL THAT THEY WILL BE GOOD
OPERATORS AFTER A FEW WEEKS OF TRAINING.

I HAVE FIVE RECEIVERS IN OPERATION ON A TWENTY-FOUR HOUR
SCHEDULE. THE SCHEDULE ENCLOSED IS OUR SHIFT. AS YOU SEE, THE OPERATORS
ARE ON DUTY SIX HOURS, WITH TWENTY-FOUR HOURS OFF, FORTY-TWO HOURS PER
WEEK. SGT. WICKMAN AND SGT. YOUNG WERE THE OPERATORS WHEN WE TOOK
