2. Each of the above-named officers will accompany enlisted men on this shipment. Relatives and friends will neither accompany the officer to the port of embarkation, nor join him there prior to embarkation.

3. Prior to departure from present station, officer will be equipped for extended field service, including clothing (summer and winter) and individual equipment as outlined in T/BA #21, 7 January, 1943, except that the following items are authorized:

Helmets, steel, M1 only (1 per individual)
Work clothing, herringbone twill only (as prescribed in T/BA #21)

Canteens will be stainless steel, plastic or aluminum.

He will have in his possession WD MD Form 81, showing inoculations and immunizations required before leaving the continental limits of the United States, and will comply with the provisions of Cir. 85, WD, 26 March, 1943, as amended by Cir. 94, 6 April, 1943.
