SUBJECT: SABOTAGE REPORT (Lt. M. C. Hawley)

TO: C.O. 1st RECN. BN. (Spec.)

Our Party left Wendi Island on 11 Oct. '44 on the U.S.S. NARWAL for the Philippines. The passage there was highlighted by a bombing by an American plane and later by the presence of two Jap destroyers off Tawi Tawi while attempting to unload. We arrived in the vicinity of TOLONG, NEGROS on the night of 19 Oct. 144 and was met by Lt. Col. Abcede, D.C. of 7th M.D.

Due to the time factor as we were already aware of the Invasion coming within a few days, we concentrated on training a groupe of men so as to get all the explosives into the field and cover as much territory as possible in the shortest time. On 25 Oct. 144 we dispatched 3 seperate groupes to cover territory in the South - Central and Northern areas of Negros. The men of our Demolition Unit were all assigned to accompany these 3 parties into the field so as to supervise and control all demolition work accomplished. Both L t. Schmaltz and myself went into the field to supervise work and train additional men in the forward areas. Our objective was to work from the south, Dumaguete-Bais area all the way north until the complete circuit had been covered.

During our 6 1/2 months of operation in Negros we have received 3 shipments of Demol ition supplies from GHQ. We did not receive a ny rations of food, clothing or cigarettes, but lived off the country. You will find attached the folder entitled SABOTAGE REPORT consisting of 11 pages of verified sabotge missions, as well as the financial report covering our mission.

I take this opportunity to express the appreciation for the excellent work accomplished by the members of this groupe and recomend them highly for daring, courage and results, namely, SGT. MANUTA = SGT. GARCES - SGT. QUEZADA - SGT. ANTIKOLL.
