and S.O. of 81st Motor Transport Company. Orders  
made out but papers destroyed by enemy invasion.  
These facts known by Naval officers Captain HENRY COAN GOC,  
Lieutenants BUCKLEY, AKERS, and COX of PT Squadron three.  
On April 20, 1942 Major General SHARP addressed HEDGES  
as Captain. This headquarters urges clarification of  
status of this valuable officer.
