SUBJECT: Attendance at Intelligence School  
TO : Commanding General, USAFFE, Thru Channels.

1. Requested I be detailed to attend an Army Intelligence School in the United States.

2. For the past 8 months I have been active in general intelligence work, having been sent to Mindoro, P. I., on secret intelligence mission prior to landings in the Philippines. I was instrumental in obtaining desired information needed in General Dunkel's Mindoro operations, also establishing radio stations in Batangas, Manila, Marikina, Labang and Marinduque Islands with net control stations in Mindoro. Our counter espionage system was a highly organized unit credited with rescuing and evacuating grounded flyers and prisoners of war. Our timely discovery and report of Jap suicide Q-boats in Balayan and Batangas Bays enabled our patrol crafts and bombers to attack and render unserviceable the aforementioned Q-boats and thereby removed the threat to our shipping.

3. Having duly completed our mission successfully and knowing too well the value of learning the newest and latest in any undertaking, I would like to chance to study further in this work.
