1. The C.O. 10th Military District has recommended that Captain James R. Grinstead, 0688877, be promoted to the grade of Lieut. Colonel.

2. This officer was appointed Captain in the AUS by Par. 3, S.O. 50, Headquarters, USAFFE. His position in the 10th Military District organization is similar to that of Bowler and Hedges, both of whom now hold the grade indicated.

3. I recommend that promotion to the grade of Lieut. Colonel be effected and that adjustments in commissioned status of the officer specifically recommended by the C.O. 10th Military District in his attached message, number 766, 13 March, be accomplished if legal authority exists to support such action. This officer's area of responsibility is a most important one.


