



1. Recommend that the following named Medical officer, now on duty with the 5217th Reconnaissance Battalion (Prov) be promoted to the grade of Major:

2. This officer has been on duty with the unit mentioned since 12 September 1943. From that date to the present time the records disclose there has been no new cases of venereal disease contracted within the Battalion. The importance of this lies in the fact that the men are selected for secret duties abroad and must be ready at all times for such service. This record is largely due to the efforts of Captain O'Connor, whose service in all respects has been superior.

3. I cannot too strongly commend the early promotion of this officer to your favorable consideration.

4. Officer has held his present grade since 7 January 1943.
