O. 500 My dear Dr. Roter: Deference is made to your letter of 12 December 1944, requesting elucidation as to why your requisition for medical supplies for the San Isidro area, Leyte, was disapproved whereas your requisition for food supplies for the same area was approved. For the first few months of re-occupation, minimum quantities of civilian supplies and other militarily necessary items were requisitioned, based on that portion of the civilian population who will come in contact with our forces. Consequently until such time as sufficient relief medical supplies become available for other areas, we shall have to use our available stocks within the perimeter of active military operations. 
