



This is to certify that no army gave me blankets except the one I am using now which I borrowed from licente Caratay, a paisanc of mine. When I left KRM I promised to return this to him if I will be furnished. In other words I have no blanket of my own. It. Labrador gave me one in Tacloban, but the billeting office at the 6th army permit no one to bring out blankets. So, I remained it at Tent C-X where It. Ibay and myself stayed.

Also no one gave me food supplies for the station KRM. We were given only can goods for our trip. Of sourse, we did not consume them all, but I have divided them among the men with me. If there was instruction to deliver the can goods to station KRM I should have done it for I am old enough to follow instructions.

Instruct Capt. Frayna to stay in your station until Gov. Escudero arrive from Leyte. I do not have much use for him now in my station.

How many ex-Usaffe men do you have in your station? How much have you advanced Cpl. Martin Praga? You know we have very limited funds for our operational expenses. If the ex-Usaffe men are not badly in need of money, we better not give them any partial pay this time. After all, if they have money they will be tempted to gamble and spend it in a foolish way. For laundry expenses, get it from your operational expenses.







1. Relief of my financial account with Lt. Colonel C. M. Smith, C.O. 95rd Div. is respectfully requested, for the following reasons:

- (a) That I am going on a mission outside of Samar under orders of the UHQ, SWPA. That I am leaving very soon. That in accomplishing said mission I may not be able to return to samar until the end of this present war.
- (b) That on Oct. 26, 1944; Uapt. A. B. Arrieta advanced me two hundred (P200.00) pesos for the subsistence of the unit assigned to harass the Japs along Taft-Wright Road. That on Nov. 21, 1944, I received from Lt. Col. C. M. Smith, Four Thousand Pesos (P4000.00) for the expenditures of the Taft Campaign.
- (c) That since Oct. 27 to Nov. 28, 1944, I have disposed under receipts simed by responsible · officers a total amount of Four Thousand one hundred eighty nine pesos (F4189.00). This amount was empended for the subsistence of the men and the transportation of supplies needed in the front. That some of the money issued to officers are not yet expended. They are still being used in purchasing palay for the subsistence of the men. That the different officers concerned were instructed to account for the money given to them. Inclosed is the detailed finencial account together with true copies of the corresponding receipts signed by the officers concerned. The genuine receipts will be sent as soon as needed.

2. In view of the foregoing reasons, I hope that this request will be favorably considered,

GUERILLA MESSAGE CENTER LEGASPI, ALBAY 22 April '45 Maj. LEE TELESCO G-3, (PSS) GHQ Dear Maj. Telenco, Enclosed are my reports on our activities at station 32V. Since the 6th Army sent over here Lt. Nellist on Feb. 20, 1945, I have extended fall cooperation to him, both in gathering intelligence informations on encmy activities and in the ase of my stations. Station 32V is now at Legaspi, Albay. I was instracted to establish this station near the headquarters of the Comdg. General, United States Task Force, in this area. Station 32V is now known as the Gaerilla Message Center for Albay and Sorsogon. To obtain maximum efficiency in transmission of messages from different guerilla groups to the headquarters, each gaerilla unit has been given one (1) radio set for its ase. As soon as the present operation in Albay is over. life in this place will become normal and monotonous. I wish I will be given a chance by GHQ to take advantage of the offer to some Philippine Army officers to study in the Service Schools of the United States. I am interested in farthering my studies in intelligence and in Signal communication. I have began it already and I might as well study its system and technicalities to be of better service to my country. At present, I feel that I am not equal to the tasks and responsibilities assigned to me by GHQ. I hope you appreciate my shortcomings in this respect. If I am given this chance, please let me know how I can get in. My profound respect to you. Very respectfully,

BICOL REGIONS INT. NET STATION 32 V 31 March 1945 SUBJECT: Record of Events, Stn. 32V March 1-31 : G-3, (PSS) GHQ - SWPA 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF SUB-STATIONS. On 5 March '45. Sab.Stn. SAV was sent to Tabaco, Albay to collaborate and coordinate the intelligence reports about the enemy in the sector occupied by Flor Guerilla. On March 17, Sub-Stn. SEV was assigned to Headquarters of Sandico Guerilla to cover up intelligence reports about the enemy in his sector. On March 27, Sub-Stn. 3MB was assigned to Zabat's Headquarters for the same purpose. This assignments of Sab-Stns. to different Guerilla headquarters was made after consultation with Lt. W. Nellist, Alamo Scout Officer, and in accordance with his policy. 2. TRANSFER OF STATION. Station 32V was transferred from Sn. Juan, Casigaran, Sorsogon to Pariaan, Camalig, Albay, on 15, March 1945. As scearity precaution to my new station against enemy infiltration, I have attached to my Station a small group of neutral guerilla unit in Borsogon under Lt. Magno. This group is composed of some ex-service men with twenty five carbines, given to them by Col. Chaffe last February. This group had been working with me since 17 March 1945. ACTIVITIES AT MY NEW STN. I have closer supervision of my agents in Albay. Intelligence reports are verified before they are reported to the higher headquarters. When Maj. Barros was designated Commander of all guerillas in Camarines Sar, Sab-Stn. 407 in that area was instructed to report to him all intelligence reports of enemy activities in his province. This was done after Maj. Barros requested me to have the said Stn. attached to him. Lt. Hobbs of Camarines Norte, likewise, requested me to attach to him Sub-Stn. 9NFL which was located in his sector. Henceforth, activities of Stn. 32V was concentrated in the Provinces of Albay and Sorsogon. Maj. Inf. (0-1406) On daty G-3, (PSS) GHQ Copy furnished: G-2, U.S. 6th Army

BICOL REGIONS INT. NET STATION 32V 28 Feb. 1945 SUBJECT: Record of Events, Stn. 32V from Feb. 1 - 28, 1945 : G-3, (PSS) GHQ - SWPA TO 1. The Station remained in San Juan, Casiguran, Sorsogon. On 11 February 1945, instruction was received from GHQ that control of Station 32V was transferred to the U. S. Sixth Army. Accordingly Stn. JD2M was contacted. This call sign was later changed to JJ12. 2. On 3 Feb. 1945, a conference of twenty four (24) officers, (fifteen (15) Escudero and nine (9) Lapus) representing the Escudero and Lapus Guerillas, was held at Sn. Jaan, Casigaran, Sorsogon at my suggestion, for the purpose of anification. The conference failed on its desired motive but it succeeded in having a mutual anderstanding not to fight each other anymore. (See Spe-3. On 23 Feb. 1945, an airdrop was made at San Juan. Among those dropped were ten (10) M-1 rifles, ten (10) pistols, cal. 45 and a number of ammo. cases. The arms were intended for the protection of my Stations and for ase of my field operatives, respectively. Gov. Esendero had turned over to me only the ten (10) M-1 rifles and two (2) cases of M-1 ammo. The rest were claimed by him including the pistols which were distributed to to his officers. My field operatives and some of my officers in charge of Sab-Stns. were never given arms for their own protections against enemy action. 4. On 27 Feb. 1945, Sab-Stn. 


