LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

In the name of God, Amen:

I, Richard K. Sutherland, Lieutenant General, U. S. Army, in the field, being of sound mind and memory do make, publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament.

First: I direct payment of my just debts.

Second: I give, devise and bequeath unto my beloved wife, Josephine Whiteside Sutherland, presently residing at the Kennedy Warren Apartments in the City of Washington, District of Columbia, U.S.A., all of the residue of the property, real personal and mixed, of which I may die possessed; should my said wife predecease me, then and in that event, I give, devise and bequeath all of the said property to my daughter, Mrs. Robert B. Carney, Jr., presently residing with my said wife.

Third: I do hereby name my said wife, Josephine Whiteside Sutherland, or if she should predecease me, then and in that event, my said daughter, Mrs. Robert B. Carney, Jr., executrix of this last Will and Testament and direct that in either case no bond be required.

Hereby revoking all wills and codicils heretofore by me made.
