TO GENERAL MACARTHUR REPORTING ALL MEN PRESENT AND CRYPTOGRAPHIC PAPERS INCLUDING CRYSTALS ARE SAFE ON HAND. ESTABLISHED STATION SOUTHEAST OF NUEVA ERA LOCATED ON COORDINATES *18°42'-120°40'* REFER MAP LUZON NUMBER *N-35*. ALL RADIO SETS BROUGHT DOWN FROM SUBMARINE WERE OUT OF ORDER EXCEPT ONE SET OF SCR288. DELAY OF COMMUNICATIONS DUE TO CONTINUOUS MOPPING OPERATIONS OF ENEMY ON US SINCE LANDING, HARD TIME OF CARRYING EQUIPMENTS FOR NO COOPERATION OF PEOPLE OF BANGUI WHICH IS INFESTED OF SPIES AND JAPS, THE SECURING OF RADIO MAINTENANCE MAN, SULPHURIC ACID, GASOLINE FOR 3BZ. POWER UNIT OF NEW SET WAS NOT BROUGHT DOWN FROM SUBMARINE.

DIFFICULTY IS DUE TO OPERATIONAL DIFFICULTIES INCIDENTAL TO NEWLY ESTABLISHED 121ST INFANTRY REGIMENTAL NET, WHICH DIFFICULTIES ARE FAST BEING STRAIGHTENED OUT. NR 6 01 JANUARY (TYPED INCOMPLETE, PART FOUR MISSING)

REPORT 341, 01 JANUARY, REFER YOUR NUMBER 17, FISHERMEN WHO SWEEP MINES TO OBTAIN POWDER FOR BLASTING FISH HAVE MADE NO REPORTS OF ELECTRICAL MINES OF ANY TYPE IN LINGAYEN GULF. THERE WAS A FIELD OF 60 TO 70 MINES LAID BY USAFFE LTSTARY OF WAR ON GENERAL LINE DOS HERMANOS ISLANDS - PORO POINT THAT, ACCORDING TO LOCAL RUMOR, WAS ELECTRICALLY CONTROLLED BUT CONTROL WIRES HAVE LONG SINCE SUPPOSED TO HAVE BEEN DESTROYED. LAST TIME FISHERMEN WERE ALLOWED IN THIS AREA IN AUGUST 1944 ONLY FIVE OF THESE MINES REMAINED, OTHERS HAVING BEEN SWEEP OR WASHED ASHORE. FISHERMEN ARE NOW BARRED FROM THIS AREA BY FREQUENT MOTORBOAT PATROLS. IF THERE ARE ELECTRICAL MINES IN THIS AREA, THEY HAVE BEEN PLACED(PART FOUR MISSING)ENEMY PLANTED SEVENTEEN MINES 150 METERS APART AND SEVEN METERS BELOW SURFACE IN CENTRAL CURVED LINE WITH FLANKS APPROXIMATELY 700 YARDS OFF SHORE BETWEEN BALINGASAY POINT AND ^{LUCENA} LUCENA (755.07-1985.06). THESE MINES ARE ABOUT ONE METER IN DIAMETER

THERE ARE TWO CRISS CROSS RUNWAYS EACH 800 YARDS LONG, ONE RUNNING DUE EAST AND THE OTHER RUNNING ALONG 60 DEGREE AZIMUTH. RUNWAYS ARE NOW BEING LENGTHENED TO 1,000 YARDS. COMMUNIQUE NR 4 JANUARY 7, DELAYED REPORT SAYS THAT COMPANY C OF 121 INFANTRY BLASTED BRIDGE AT NAGUILIAN ON BAUANG - BAGUIO ROAD ON MORNING OF JANUARY 7 WITH UNKN RESULTS. SAME ROAD NAGUILIAN TO BURGOS BEING BLOCKED BY TREES AND ROCKS. CONFIRMED THAT BAUANG RAILROAD BRIDGE DESTROYED. CABUGAO AND PANGADAN BRIDGES ILOCOS SUR DESTROYED AND LASON BRIDGE PARTIALLY DESTROYED. ONE REGIMENT ENEMY TROOPS FROM LA UNION ARRIVED BANGUED ABRA DECEMBER 28, NOW QUARTERED ALL HOUSES EAST PART OF TOWN. GENERAL AND OTHER TROOPS EXPECTED TO ARRIVE AND MAYORS OF LAPAZ, TAYUM AND LAGANGILANG ORDERED TO PREPARE TO QUARTER TROOPS. WE ARE NOW IN RADIO CONTACT WITH 15TH INFANTRY IN ILOCOS NORTE BUT NOT WITH 14TH INFANTRY IN VIZCAYA.
