Mindanao Station: - NR 924 - 16 April/44 - (Weekly coast watcher report ending 16 April) General or special comment: Total targets for week 140. East coast more active. Several warships both ways thru Basilan.

NR 869 - 9 April/44 - One navy flying boat "Kanaski" over Manay, Davao province, east to open sea. First ship movements along east coast are being reported. Traffic will increase in that lane with change in Monsoon.

NR 872 - 10 April/44 - About 16,000 good Jap troops in Davao Province. Proposed road from Malalag to Buanyan, Cotabato, south tip of Talicud Island fortified, but none on Samal, Davao Province.

NR 873 - 10 April/44 - Seaplanes based near Isabela, Basilan Island.

NR 877 - 11 April/44 - Large launce tried to land at Manay, Davao, but withdrew to south after firing 12 three-inch shells.

NR 878 - 11 April/44 - Cagayan, Mis. Or., wharf area closed now to civilians. They probably expect naval units.

NR 879 - 11 April/44 - Heavy plane patrols during Palau attack have slackened. Have not sighted warships since they entered Davao Gulf. The 12 warships which passed point Diuata have not been seen passing through Surigao Strait.

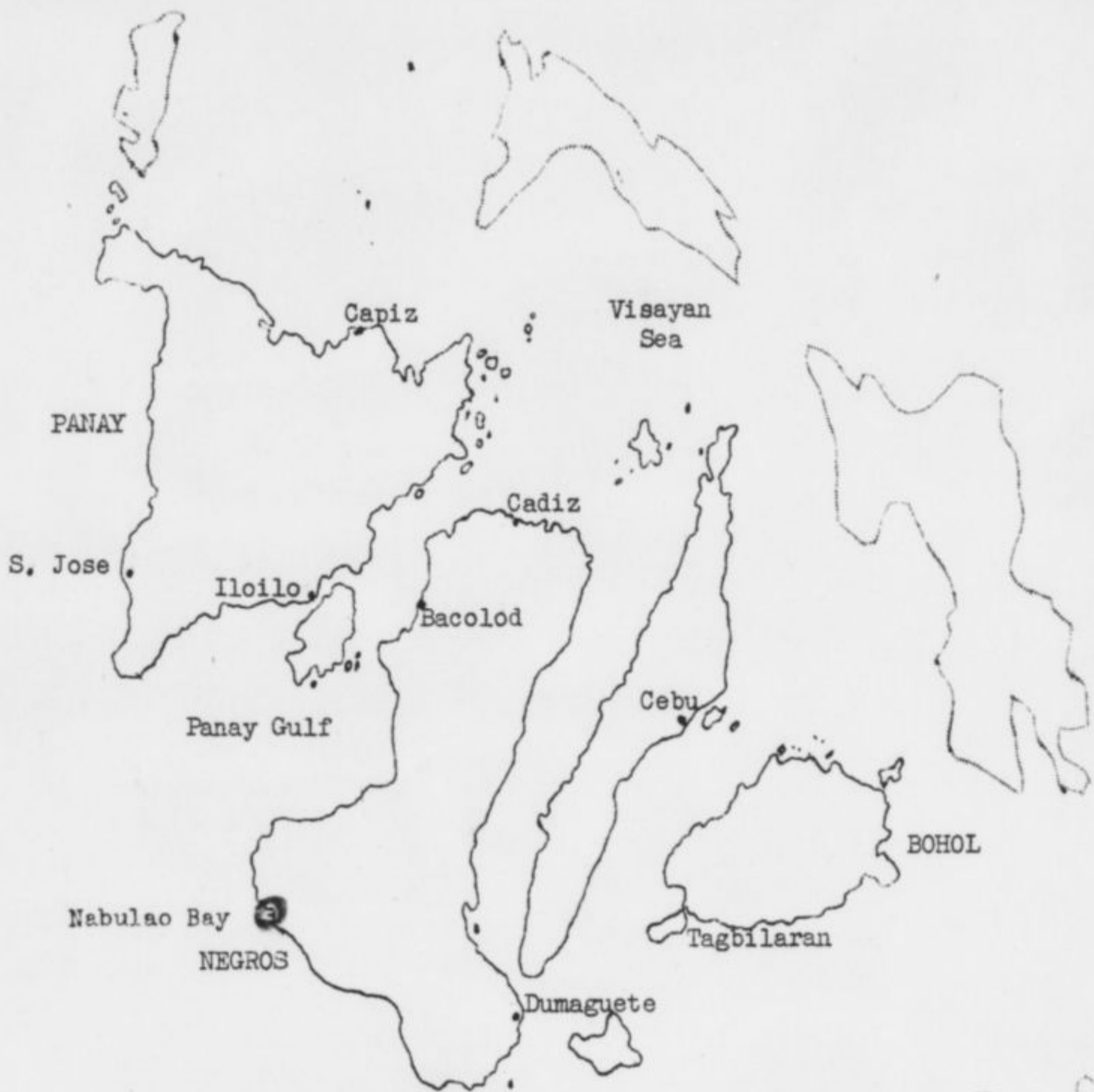

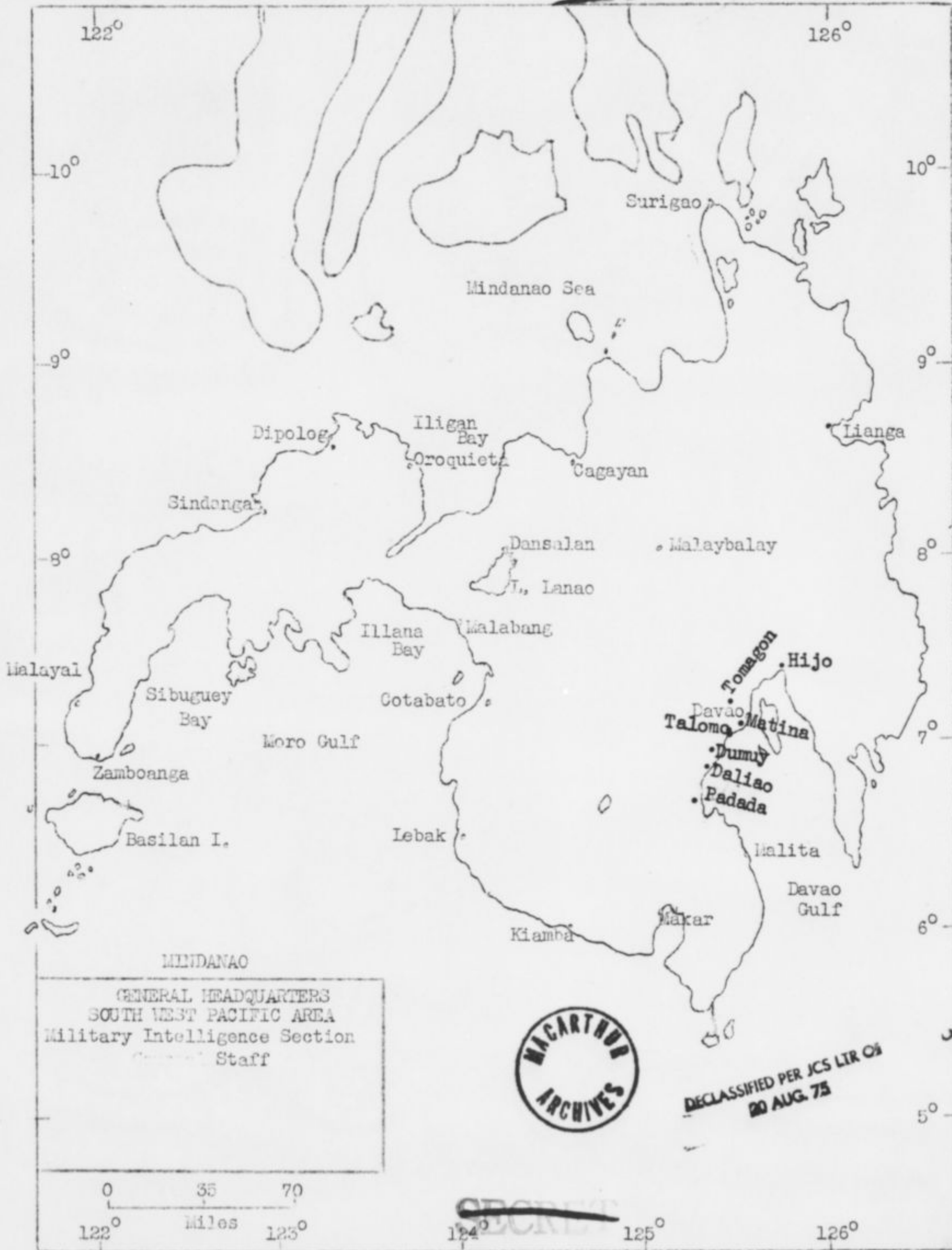

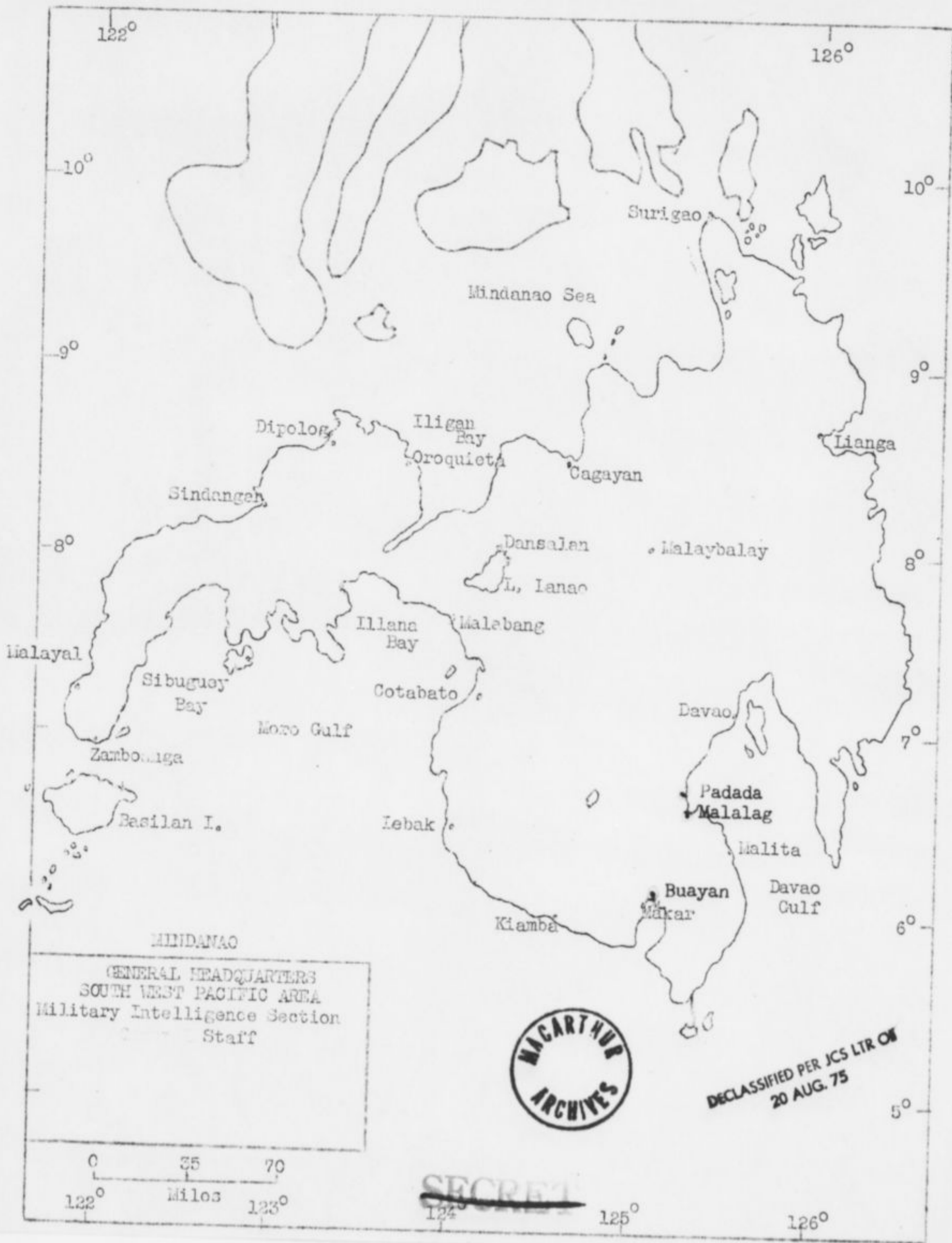
