Comment: CUSHING requested authority to issue bonds in view of our failure to supply him with Philippine currency. We replied that this headquarters was without authority to authorize the issuance of bonds which was primarily a legislative function and queried him for clarification as to the type of currency permitted circulation in his area.

This message confirms that the use of enemy script is compulsory in CEBU. We have sent in \$200,000 and will continue to send it in as the opportunity presents itself.

This message is the first direct communication from CUSHING using his own code which we furnished him - discloses that our supplies are getting through and this new channel for communication opening up satisfactorily.

> Arising from his appointment, ABOGADO has no legal status as Governor. There is much confirmed criticism of MERRITT and his guerilla unit (FERTIG, SMITH and JURIKA). Recognition of ABOGADO by President QUEZON might, because of the nature of his appointment, have unfortunate repercussions in areas of SAMAR over which MERRITT has no measure of control.

It is difficult to explain the situation to President QUEZON or guide his action and so I doubt the advisability of forwarding the message.

- 1. My comment is asked on G-2 note of 29 March, attached. Here it is. First I must advise (a) that the work in reference does not some from the labors of any new additions to PRS (same officer responsible same sergeant doing the job) and (b) that its sole purpose lies in the presentation of a dispatch, otherwise unintelligible, to the Chief of Staff in a manner capable of being understood. Hence the map indicating the positions of radio stations in reference -- the breakdown of corresponding coastwatcher signals -- and the resume of other signals received during the period involved bearing upon enemy naval movement in Philippine waters.
- 2. In the work, there is no attempt at "intelligence appraisal, evaluation or dissemination, etc.", but it is limited to a <u>factual</u> report in amplification of a message summarising weekly developments which standing alone would be othersie, as before stated, wholly unintelligible. I believe that if G-2 will re-examine the report more closely it will find it to be, rather than an encroachment upon or duplication of G-2 responsibilities as suggested, just another PRS pick and showel job little deserving of commendation or other mention.
- 3. As to G-2's suggestion that the responsible officer (Col. Whitney) should be assigned to the Philippine section of G-2 to "cover that phase of P.I. Intelligence" I feel that it is an honor that I could not in good conscience personally advance in view of the apparent misinterpretation by G-2 of the nature and value of the work involved.
- 4. PRS shall not relax in its search for the means that will permit its
 the better to meet its responsibilities in the common cause and shall vigorously
 and happily pursue any change in present procedure which merits and meets with
 the approval of the Chief of Staff.



In the final analysis it is of course for President QUEZON to appoint the members of the Currency Committee and I rather reluctantly believe that the message should be laid before him. It is possible that he would note CONFESOR's absence from consideration and call for his views. The general financial situation does not look too good.





With respect to Mr. Norbert Schmelkes, I have known him personally since 1936. As I recall he was a Commodity Broker and supposedly one of Manila's leading copra handlers. It was my understanding that he was connected with Mr. Max Kummer, about whom you already know, however, that cannot be confirmed at present. It was further understood that Mr. Schmelkes was the representative or consul for the Czeckoslovakian Government.

Mr. Schmelkes was one of the organizers in collaboration with the national committee in establishing the National Produce Exchange and wrote the section directly relating to copra.


I had some business dealings with Mr. Schmelkes which always turned out satisfactorily but do not have extensive information regarding his social activities either with the Filipinos or the Americans. However, his friends and associates seemed to be, for the most part, Europeans, and he appeared to be favorably considered by most of the Philippine Government Politicos.

I am not certain as to the man's citizenship and have never heard any derogatory remarks neither towards him personally nor his activities.
