With reported landing in considerable force at ASIA this new enemy action further complicates the south coast possibilities for successful contact. We are going in though very shortly with a full load of supplies which should see the 7th M. D. through until air dropping can be arranged. I still have a hunch that this tightening of the NEGROS blockade is related to the vital enemy documents already received but which the enemy thinks are still in CUSHING's possession. (given until 31 May to deliver).





"Colonel" Tome BITENG formerly with PERALTA fell out with the latter and wandered down to TAWITAWI and BRITISH NORTH BORNEO. A party, headed by Capt. Guillermo de la CRUZ, was sent here by Colonel BITENG in January last to secure supplies and funds for an organization claimed to be set up in North BORNEO consisting of 12,000 men and styled "American Forces in MALAYA."

Examination of CRUZ and the members of his party led to the conviction that BITENG was but an opportunist attempting to secure aid from this headquarters. Statements made upon arrival of the party were found to be fabrications in which they were instructed by BITENG himself in order that they might better "get the aid he wanted."

In view of the radio silence at present imposed upon YOUNG's radio station, until necessary to report a large naval or air movement from that area, I believe that BITENG's message should be ignored.
