Re Fertig 249:

1. Except for the 9 unidentified planes over San Dionisio on 8 June all the above traffic is normal and follows the established main route from Manila to Davao.

2. This message as to the 9 unidentified planes, taken in conjunction with navy messages received relating to air traffic on 8 June leads to the conclusion that a minimum of 25 aircraft in 3 flights were bound for the Davao area. These 25 aircraft probably consisted of 16 bombers and 9 fighters.

Re Fertig 247:

1. Zamboanga City and Province present interesting strength reports. From 4 to 15 May, strength increased from 500 to 1000. 25 May it was reported as confirmed that 5000 Nips were stationed in Zamboanga Province; 3500 in city, 1500 on outskirts. 29 May - midnight, all but few enemy troops returned to Zamboanga City. Much confusion reported in the movement. 1 June - enemy left area (outside Zamboanga City) so rapidly that food, clothing and other supplies were left behind. 1 June - during period 15-30 May, 10000 Nips passed thru Zamboanga City going north (presumed by boat to the north). 5 June - 6000 Nips arrived Cagayan.

2.a. Possibility that Zamboanga Province garrison of 5-6000 were rushed out for some reason. Whether to go to Cagayan or south is not known.

b. Possibility that report of only 200 Nips at Zamboanga City refers to city only, with balance of the 5000 definitely reported on May 25, still in area north of city

c. We will assume Zamboanga Province strength of 5000, pending clarification. We will query Fertig on this matter.





Re Fertig 245:

This is a substantial movement of aircraft for each of the days mentioned, and is out of the ordinary with respect to number and with respect to location. Masbate is not on the normal air route from Manila to Davao. The only logical explanation of these unusual flights is that the aircraft came from the Bicol Provs., Luzon. Prior to 1 May it was reported that there were 195 aircraft on 2 of the Bicol airfields (Pili, Tiwi). The accuracy of the report of 195 aircraft was seriously doubted but now it appears probable that there were a substantial number of aircraft on these 2 fields. It is believed that some of the airplanes observed flying over Masbate are those which are now in the Bacolod (Negros) area undergoing training. The only logical place for the balance of the aircraft to have gone, is the Davao area. This would account for large numbers of aircraft in the Davao area in the early part of May. Whether the Bicol area airfields are to be used as staging areas in the future is not clear. It is quite possible that these fields were used as staging bases solely because the Manila-Clark Airfields were still undergoing major construction.
