Precis: In re JOSE PAEZ.

Comment: JOSE PAEZ, former manager of the Manila Railroad, is now member of the Council of State and The Economic Planning Board, manager of the Philippine Red Cross and head of the Civilian Air Raid Protection Organization.

We have no information on which to gauge the individual loyalties of JOSE PAEZ or the officers of his organization or the ability of their wives to remain silent about the receipt of medicine from here, nor can we evaluate ANDERSON's judgement in such matters. As a consequence a cautious policy would appear indicated until we know more about the situation. The potential value of ANDERSON and his group is too great to take any chance on the compromise of his position at this time.

Action recommended:

Advise ANDERSON that until medicines can be delivered in such quantity or will more than meet the requirements of his command and those immediately associated with him in the same work, they should be conserved for such purpose. Caution him against any action which might result in compromise to his position or to our agents with whom he comes in contact.

Comment: On 29 April PERALTA in his message NR 162 advised, "ABOUT APRIL 20, NIPS PLACED WHITE FLAGS, WHITE POSTS, OR PAINTED PROMINENT LANDMARKS AND ROCKS WITH WHITE PAINT ON SEVERAL POINTS ALONG AJUY - BAROTAC VIEJO COAST AND IN SEVERAL ISLANDS OFF SAID COAST. BELIEVE THEM TO BE FOR SHIPS PASSING THROUGH CHANNEL BUT NOT SURE. SPECIFIC PLACES AVAILABLE IF DESIRED". Action taken on BONDOC POINT may be responsive to similar purpose. ENEMY ABANDONED TO IMPROVE USAFFE LANDING FIELD ORMOC. VALENCIA LANDING FIELD ALMOST COMPLETED. LOCATED EIGHT MILES NORTH 10 DEGREES WEST ORMOC TOWN, ONE KILOMETER NORTH BARRIO VALENCIA AND 500 METERS WEST OF AND PARALLEL TO ORMOC - VALENCIA HIGHWAY. RUNWAY 200 METERS WIDE AND ONE AND HALF KILOMETERS LONG, SINGLE RUNWAY WITHOUT CROSS RUNWAY. RUNWAY ROLLED WITH SAND SURFACING. NO REVETMENT. BELIEVE IT IS AVAILABLE FOR USE ANYTIME. NO HANGARS. FOX HOLES AND AIR RAID SHELTERS CONSTRUCTED FEW METERS AWAY FROM RUNWAY. NO OTHER FACILITIES. NO DISPERSAL POINT EXCEPT FEW COCONUT TREES ABOUT 400 METERS WEST RUNWAY. NO PLANE MADE LANDING EVER SINCE. RUMORS HAD IT THAT THIS LANDING FIELD WILL BE MADE NAVAL TRAINING AIR STATION AND PLANES WILL BE STATIONED THERE.

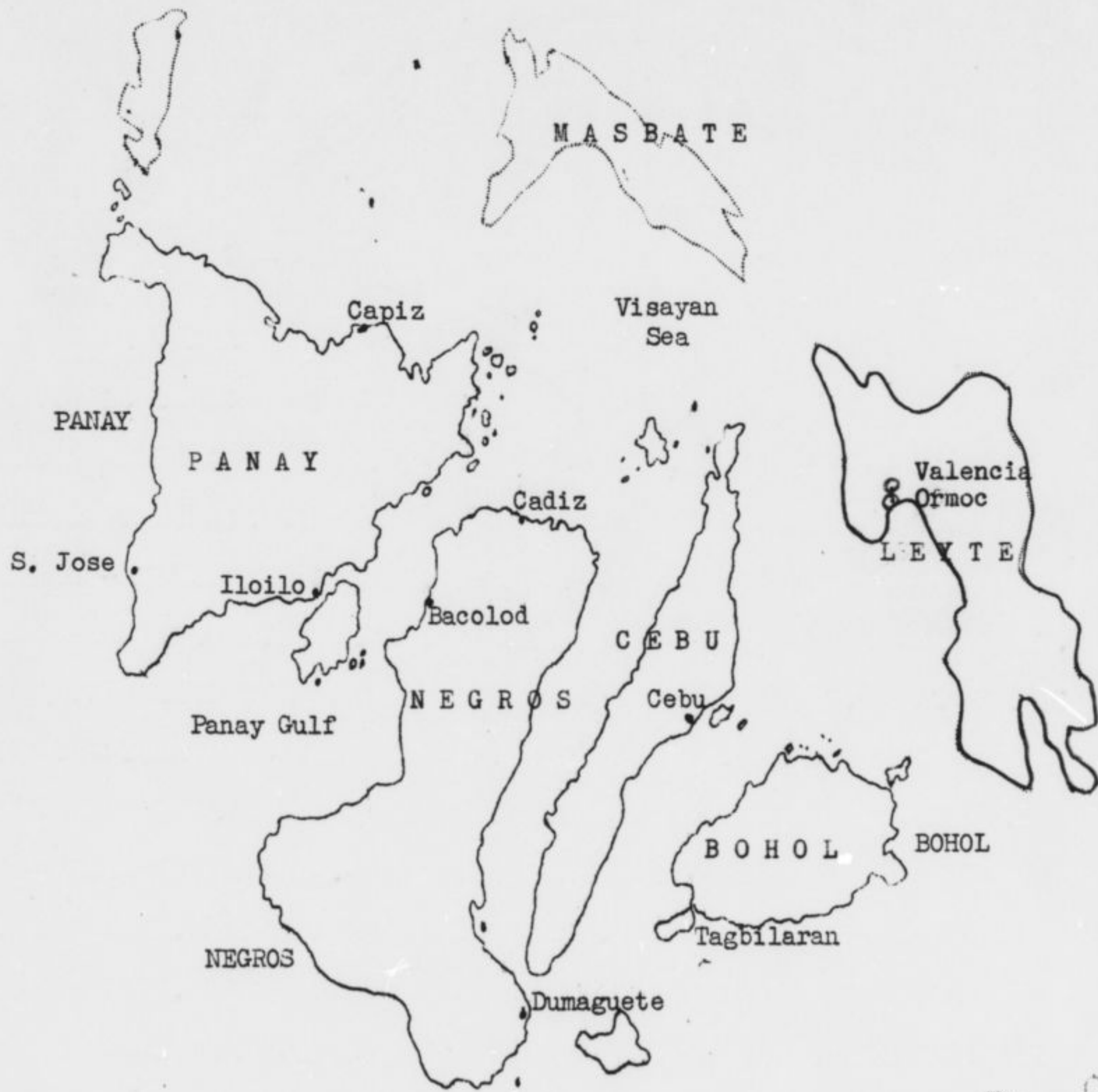

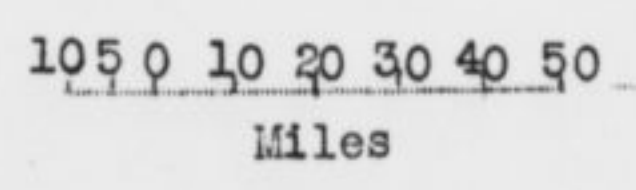

Comment: Interpretation of YOUNG's "pidgin English" would appear to be:

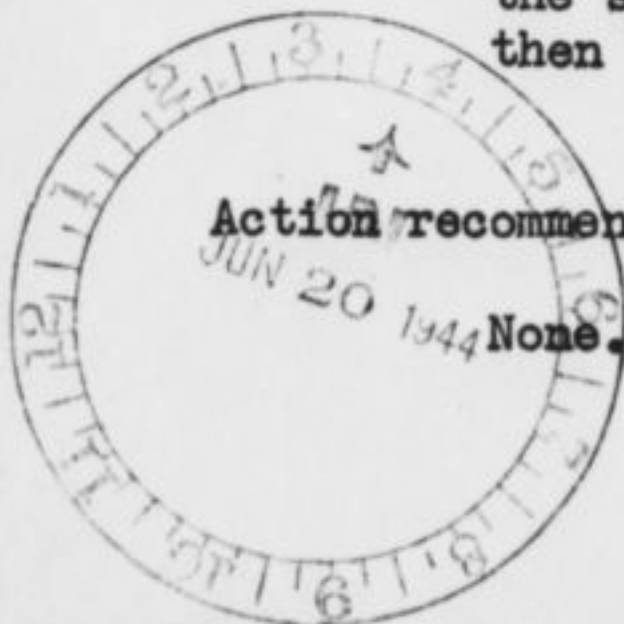
That he acknowledges receipt of the C in C's message of confidence, encouragement and instruction; that he has been doing the same job for which commended since departure of Captain HAMNER in addition to his LUZON experience; that our reinforcing party can better carry on in the SULUS if he (YOUNG) is appointed commander of the party "with proper rank"; that he (YOUNG) has received his present commission of 1st Lieutenant in the hard way while officer arriving by sub would have received his commission easy way; that five tons of supplies should be sent him including transmitter with loud speaker for main station and three smaller stations, spares, medicine, three BARs, 2 batteries, 12 jungle hammocks, clothing, cigarettes and funds; that as a special request he would like a portable mimeographing machine, etc., "for enlightening morale Moro civilians." He queries whether he should call for the arms, funds, medicine, etc., the sub could not discharge due to enemy action to be returned with view to reorganizing the regiment with new commander named later.

YOUNG advised that when a reinforcing party can be sent to TAWITAWI the supplies he has listed will be included and consideration will then be given to naming him to command the party.

Precis: In re ANDERSON's contact with B.C.

Comment: ANDERSON's action in placing his own men in the Constabulary appears to be the proper approach to the B.C. question - one that FERTIG has been unable to appreciate. The greatest value of the men rests upon their remaining with the Constabulary until the C in C gives them other instructions. In that manner we will not only retain a highly accredited means for information on enemy activity but we will have armed troops at our disposal already infiltrated into the enemy's midst. Wholesale desertion now would make the enemy suspicious of all members of the Constabulary remaining on duty and neutralize their value to us.
