### Information Report No. 622

The following is the substance of reports received from Timor up to 28th June, 1943: -

- (1) According to native reports, there has been a considerable withdrawal of enemy troops from the vicinity of LAUTEM during the past week.
- (2) Concurrently it is reliably reported that Jap forces at Ossu, Viqueque and Be Aco have been strengthened. In the opinion of a Portuguese observer the Japs are building up garrison strength in central points such as Ossu and at likely invasion points such as Be Aco in the southern litteral of Sac Demingos province at the expense of Lautem and other north coast garrisons.
- (3) There are 700 Japs comped above the small reservoir at Ossu and about 500 in the bush behind the Customs shed at Be Aco.
- (4) A mid-month Jap patrol starting from Viqueque followed the road to the Luca River and then followed the river to the beach and back east to Be Aco. Luca River is about as far west as the enemy 'scouts' from Be Aco without the use of matives. Farther west, past the Bilor to Kiras, patrol is left to a mative outfit whose performance is apt to be perfumetory.
- (5) In lower Memmtute, Kerns appears to be the main garrison point with about 100 Japa. At Cribas, Inclubar, Fatu Berliu and Berique there are only a few Japa at each of these posts.
- (6) At Be Aco hundreds of matives have lately been employed in bringing in the makings of two colossel bonfires as "invasion signals to Ossu", probably by way of presention against the certainty of loyalist disruptive activities in the event of an Allied landing.
- (7) The Viqueque-Be Aco road has been repaired and is now in fair condition, empable of enrying reasonable noter traffic in the dry season. The ten-mile stretch of roadway from the beach to Viqueque is runcured to be heavily mined and it is definitely known that machine-gum nests exist in the tree tops, particularly in the vicinity of the anchorage itself.
- (8) The chief road construction operation in the province is taking on the Baguia-Unto Carabau track. Here the eight miles of tiring simuosities of the old track are being improved across and along the ridges and tributaries of the Salibere River with the object of completing a cross-island road from the Ira Bere River close to the south coast to the northern anchorage of Lags.







The following information has been received from TIMOR during the period 29th June to 23rd July, 1943: The bembing referred to in paragraph 6 has now been arranged: a. The Japanese, with the support of natives, continue to seek the bend of 70 Pertuguese refugees which recently was surprised and attacked with mortars and machine guns by two b. A report received on 31/7/43 states that during the bombing by our aircraft of LAUTEM (presumably on 2nd and 3rd June) over one hundred Japanese were killed and many wounded. Included among the killed was one senior officer - rank not c. It is also reported (21/7/43) that the Japanese are withdrawing from ALIAMBATA (on South Coast) but are retaining one O.P. comprising four men at BABULO. NOTE: BABULO is situated approximately 15 miles North of d. Portuguese Party Leader reports that the Japanese are informing the Natives that an Allied invasion of Timor is imminent. 2. Information from Native sources indicates that some of Jap troops in Eastern Timor have been service in New Guines. 1. From information received from reliable sources the Porto Leader gives CESU, in Central SAO DOMINGOS Province, as the main point of enery troop concentration in Eastern Timor. He has repeatedly urged the bombing of this point, so far without response. Incidentally he says that the bombing of GSU would relieve enemy pressure on the refugees and would expedite their evacuation. 

Information Reference (Source) At KAIMANA Japanese Infantry are quartered in NEFIS cocomut plantation at KASIR PANDJANG (2 km S.E. July 8, 1943 from KAIMANA). The troops are under the command of a Lieut. Colonel. a. A native Government official gives the fol-NEFIS lowing information about AMEON up to 15 February: July 12, 1943 Garrison Ambon total approximately 5000 men. Old Netherlands positions are in use and also the Tolehoe position (sit. 3035.5'S, 128020.5'E) near warm spring. Marines in fort Victoria and internees camp. Army in benteng (fort), Mulo school and Esplanade Hotel. Airbases Laha, Liang and Halong. At Laha now 30 fighters according to information of the beginning of April. A/A batteries near the acrodrome and benteng (fort), T.B.C. Hospital and - - - - on corner of Velentyn street. All churches and schools in town are supply dumps which have not yet been bombed. Request bombing. Population is waiting for this and has already fled. Bomb dumps in internees camp and barracks native conscripts at Batoe Merah. Japs are building dock at WALJAME. b. Japs are still at FMAROTALI and make regular patrols consisting of 5 Japs and 5 - 8 natives. Everywhere they have been, the population has already fled. The Japanese are making gardens at ENAROTALI which are destroyed overnight by mountain natives. Up to this date there have been no Jap planes at WISSELLAKES. KEKWA NEFIS Trenches have been constructed along the coast July 14, 1943 and also barbed wire entanglements. There are no anti-tank guns. The Japs have not prepared a track for retreat or stores in the interior. There are indications that an aerodrome is under NEFIS construction on the KEBAR plain (about 25 miles July 19, 1943 west to southwest from MANOKWARI). 1101 -1-

Information Reference (Source) Bombing of airdrome at NABIRE has been very NEF IS effective. Thirty to fifty Japs and workmen July 24, 1943 were killed during each raid. The airdrome was given up by the Japanese who left only 50 Japs on guard, who were billeted at the NABAROWO River 12 miles E. of MABIRE. Possible airdrome KEBAR PLAIN at 0040' S and between 133015' E and 132045' E, general direction Bast/West. NEFIS The Japanese employed in construction of airdrome July 26, 1943 on KEBAR Plain are said to come from PALAO. Reliable information states that there are no airdromes at MOMI and WAREN but only rice fields layed out by the Japs. Information about NABIRE up to 15th June states that the Japanese originally intended to build a big airdrome. They had 300 soldiers under command of a captain, 600 Japs labour corps ex PALAO, 900 natives, 10 tractors, 100 lorries, 50 trucks. The airdrome was to be for 100 planes. There were no A/A guns - only machineguns. The A/A guns visible were wooden dummies. Bombs were stored near Jap huts west of airdrome.
