





- 1. Attached message discloses re-establishment of contact with Young on TAWITAWI. There are a number of points requiring clarification and additional information desired which is being worked out in close coordination with navy.
- 2. YOUNG's position is of utmost importance to us during this period and the determined spirit he has exhibited in re-establishing communication with us exemplifies the highest standard of devotion to duty that you would ask of any element in forward positions.
- 3. YOUNG left here as a 2nd Lieutenant. I recommend his promotion one grade and notification of same by commendatory message from the C in C as follows:
 - "I commend you for courage and resourcefulness that has permitted you to sustain your position and report on enemy dispositions in that area despite heavy enemy pressure. In recognition of that service I have promoted you to the grade of first lieutenant in the Army of the United States"
- 4. If above action is approved I will process the matter through USAFFE for the necessary administration prior to dispatch of message proposed.
