Southern Cebu clear to receive shipment after several weeks penetration by enemy. If personal interview in that headquarters desired I would be willing to bail out in this area from plane if conditions would permit their reaching this far.

First and second installments our supplies, reference your NR 25, arrived Cebu. Our mail bag containing only one letter from Chick Parsons with invoice and some propaganda forced open along with other boxes marked CG. Quartermaster 7thMD when apprised this fact answered he promised minimize "expected losses under the attending circumstances" as mentioned by Abcede, our signal supplies will be sent last. Latter part this month we have suffered several enemy penetrations lasting from 2 to 3 days causing slight damage only. Naval reports with night observation are facilitated **how** by OP's at coast line. Aerial observation, reference your NR special dated July 14, change into operation first week August using our present three stations. The Tommies MGS not mentioned in your NR 25 came as a pleasant surprise

and we are indeed grateful for the entire shipment.

My staff officers request I reiterate loss of supplies at seventh military district. Cebu area QMC officers in Seventh military district reports all boxes marked OG opened with (Nicknacks) and signal equipment stolen, in Western Negros relay station, 40 carbines are taken by unit OC Spt. Villarin who has refused to turn them over in spite of the order of his commanding officer, Lt. Co. Aspilla to that effect. My first group officers and enlisted men with boats sent to handle shipment were returned to Cebu few days prior to arrival of shipment in Negros, query to Seventh military district regarding this action has not been answered. My apologies small stuff complaints, reiterating our request for shipment in Southern Cebu.

Capt Gerardo Sanches claiming to be US army allied intelligence officer formerly working around Cebu waters is requesting signal supplies from US which we do not have available. If desired suggest you advise him make his contact thru our station. He has just returned from Samar to Bohol. Also request identification as he took Cebu personnel without authority since last December. His contact man claims Americans and Filipinos landed by sub in Samar to operate in Visayas also they were attacked by Japs. Medicines captured from Nips by us valued at half million pesos.

Due last enemy drive we again short M-2 calibre Ammo and mortar shells. We request light Automatic weapons (Bar Browning Automatic Rifles and Sub Thompsons) for mobile purposes. Also large supply M-2 ammo. We have noted our original request was altered by relay station.

Convent on Busay road, former house Captain Martit's wife has three mounted anti-aircraft, with gasoline and ammunition dumps in valleys east. Ops located hill top N.E. and N.W. of convent. Along S.W. side of road cutting Lahug runway extending between Gorordo Avenue and runway are located gasoline dumps, quarters, storehouses, hospital and garages. Opposite side of road the aviators quarters, ~~storehouse~~ containing 200 new pilots, directly opposite hospital is wireless station and powerhouse with underground cable running north into hills with termination unknown yet. Former wireless station at Mandaue are gasoline and ammunition dumps also wireless station. In Pandan area, Naga which consist of a flat river valley approximately one to two kilometers in size has considerable

construction under progress. Captured enemy maps following by mail show large number buildings reported by Intelligence to be cement with Nipa camouflage. Other reports state underground constructions in surrounding hills. From various reliable reports large quantity supplies and ammunition have been transported to this area. The Lanaviera Filipina on corner Magallanes and Martires streets full of airplane bombs, Montenegro and old Provincial buildings on corner Juan Cuna and Martires Sts. are full of rifle ammunition, Phil Mfg Co and Daido Boiki Kaisha bodegas on corner Lapulapu and Magallares streets are full of rifle ammunition and 50 meters northeast of former district engineer shops near pier three are five 75 mm guns and three calibre .50 machine guns. Repaired storage tanks at Caltey, Mactan Island now have 2500 drums gasoline and oil.

We are placing a quartermaster in next delivery point to take charge of our equipment. some equipment received has apparently been used or tampered with as they are lacking in parts. We are grateful beyond words for all shipments received here and due to difficulties incurred we would appreciate help from your headquarters so that shipments not be tampered with in transit.

We received 120 carbines, two 50 cal mg, two mortars, Jap Money, medical supplies, two destroyed transceivers and other signal equipments corroded by salt water. We highly appreciate everything done for us. However, we would like more and more propaganda, as we see it here there is nothing better.

We have received an official report from the 10th Military district re loss of money and important material for us. From late info Bohol is too spy infested for shipment there. We would prefer meeting in Southern Negros. If we are to receive anything we requested earliest possible delivery as communications and travel is becoming more difficult each day. Effects of propaganda and our declaration of war against BC has gained surrender of 110 BC all armed, many with two rifles.
