Due to diversity of frequencies and lack of standardized equipment, air warning flashes from Post observers always late. Moreover, present available equipment Majority of which is not factory built is utterly inadequate for contemplated tactical missions of field units. Signal equipment so far received has been shared with Andrews for his luzon projects.

Urgently request shipment of following signal equipment by next supply vessel:

a. Three complete sets radio transmitters model TW12 with complementary communications type receivers, power plant and accessories.

b. Five complete sets radio transmitter receiver type 284A with hand cranked Generator, accessories and spare batteries.

- D) Radio electricians tools (Pliers, screw drivers, drills, punches, hammers and knives).
- E) six volt exciter lamps for projector and soldering irons.
- F) 110 volt electric plant and soldering irons.
- G) Electrolyte for storage batteries.



H) Signal corps typewriters, field manuals, message out pads for weather teams.

J) Flashlights, watches, compasses, binoculars and plotting aids for aircraft observers.
