Part I. In view of WCL 35373, CINCFE rad CX 57065 is rescinded. The following policy and procedure will apply for recall of FEC personnel to active duty:

a. Provs of WCL 34125, as amended by WCL 35373, will apply. All applications will be forwarded to CINCFE, including physical examinations, for final action and will contain detailed justification therefor.

b. CINCFE will forward to TAG only those applications for recall to field grade whose specialties are critically needed in FEC.

c. Authority is granted to waive those parts of final type physical examinations which cannot be accomplished by personnel now serving in enlisted or warrant officer status. Where this authority is exercised by other than CG, EUSAK, forwarding indorsement of major commander will include justification therefor.

Part II. Request indication of quota desired for recalls in company grade.

Part III. Officers who have been recalled to active duty under provisions of reference messages in grade lower than that to which now entitled or in Category V rather than I, II or III may resubmit request for change in status.

It is desired that plans for the evacuation to the ZI of Dependents whose principal is deceased or reported as missing or captured as a result of Korean conflict, hereafter to be referred to as project "Bluewood" be based upon the following: a. Transportation to ZI at Govt expense of dependents upon decease or upon report of missing or capture of principal authorized in case of depts of mil pers under Sec II AR 35-4880, 13 Dec 48; in case of civ pers deceased under CI DA CPM T 3. 7-8; in case of civ pers missing or captured under Sec 38, Public Law 580, 77th Congress as interpreted in DA mad 86400, 19 Jul 50. Travel will be by military air unless depts do not desire air travel. Movement to and through the port of embarkation will be expedited. No more than 30 days will be allowed to elapse between official report of KIA or MIA and departure of depts from housing area toward port except in existence of cogent reasons to the contrary. The port will be notified, as far in advance as practicable, of arrival of dependents in the port area including statement as to type of travel desired and, in case of surface transportation, whether or not dependents desire to accompany body of deceased. b. Shipment of household goods at govt expense will be expedited under provision Sec II AR 55-160, 29 Apr 49, if principal is deceased or under AR 55-121, 12 Nov 46, if missing or captured. Before dependents leave Japan, their ZI address will be furnished to the Effects QM, 8th Army Effects Depot, APO 503. This address will be used for forwarding effects to which the dependents do not have access. c. Shipment of privately owned vehicle, in case principal is deceased, is authorized by DA radio MCL 47753, 1 Mar 49, Sec 617, JAF, Bull #34, 29 November and DA radio MCL 38606, 18 February 50.

Deps will be advised of their responsibility for onward movement of vehicle from ZI port to ultimate ZI destination. When shipment by rail is involved from station in Japan to port, depts will be instructed to contact local RTO regarding security of vehicle during train trip. Shipment of auto of personnel reported missing or captured will be deferred pending DA answer to CINCPAC radio requesting authority for such shipment. d. Remains of those who die in Korea will be interred in Korea. Remains of those who die in Japan, bodies arriving in Japan in planes and on ships as a result of aerial and/or sea combat, bodies washed ashore in Japan, or under any other circumstance deceased in Japan as a result of Korean conflict, will be shipped to the ZI by surface transportation where practicable, and upon specific request of depts, shipment of remains in Japan will be coordinated with travel of depts. In unusual circumstances, requests for aerial shipment of remains under authority of DA radio WCL 45079, 3 Jun 49 will be directed to CINCPAC, attention G-1. e. Although a summary court, as required by AM 112, need not be appointed to dispose of effects unless deceased's legal representative or widow is not present, where practicable, an officer will be appointed to aid the family. Legal assistance officers and American Red Cross personnel, where available, are prepared to advise depts on such matters.

D/A msg W 87079, 27 July 50, which was passed to CG 8th Army for info, stated that, in view of the fact that a major portion of world wide assets of depot stocks of 2½ ton and 4 ton dump trucks are on hand in the FBC and that considerable lead time will be necessary to obtain new production in the EI, comments relative to ability of FBC to supply total reqmts of all FBC units for these two (2) types of vehs were desired by D/A.

2. CINCPAC msgm AG 451 was prepared on 24 July 50 for transmission to 8th Army, prior to receipt of D/A msg W87179, 27 July 50. In this msg the attention of 8th Army was called to the fact that Periodic Logistics Report No. 27, 24 July should show 40 trucks, 2½ ton dump on reqn from EI whereas rpt indicated 78 serviceable on hand, only 4 Due Out, and 3,377 unserviceable on hand. It was further stated that in view of the apparent favorable supply status of this item that consideration be given to the cancellation of the reqn on the EI for this item.

3. Msgm prepared for transmission to 8th Army now asks for the info necessary to base reply to D/A concerning dump truck status.

4. Inasmuch as a similar policy should apply to other types/high cost Ord vehs that have special bodies which can be rebuilt in Japan, par 2 of msgm requires 8th Army to develop info also on other Ord veh types and advise CINCPAC of status.

purchases. Further, that such authority was necessary to meet on-the-spot requirements of a nature essential to the accomplishment of the Eighth Army mission during the present emergency. CINCFE msgform AG 160 (23 Jul 50) GD, 23 Jul 50, advised CG Eighth Army that preliminary study indicates that the authority to execute "after the fact" contracts cannot be granted and requested additional information for use in connection with the study being made to determine a method of payment to suppliers in such cases.

2. CINCFE's reply to Eighth Army's msg D 77441 GA (19 Jul 50) was predicated on information obtained from JA on 22 Jul 50 that no authority exists for the execution of "after the fact" contracts, as such information obtained from JA (Maj Snyder) on 27 July 50 indicates that:

"Payment in the present situation could be made either (1) by use of Sec. 17a of the Contract Settlement Act, which would require a large amount of paper work, which is deemed inadvisable in the present situation, or (2) by recognizing the agency as agents of the procurement section or contracting officer, as obtaining the supplies or services with the implied intention to negotiate as to price later. By the agency supplying the contracting officer with all of the information relating to the transaction, the contracting officer can confirm or ratify the action of the agency by negotiating the contract and the entire process would be considered the negotiation which was culminated by the written contract. Based upon the data supplied by the obtaining agency the contracting officer can then proceed to make the findings for the contract file.

"The JA realizes it is difficult to justify the legality of this position if the negotiation is not considered as an action running from the agency to the contracting officer and if one opposes the theory of confirmation of the transaction by the contracting officer. However, the JA feels that, in the present situation, this solution is a logical one. The ASPR recognizes the use of negotiation in emergencies and for over-sea use, and the process of negotiation is not laid down in rigid fashion. It is felt that the spirit of the ASPR is not violated by taking this position."

JA (Maj Snyder) is of the opinion that this headquarters can grant authority to negotiate contracts confirming the procurement of supplies and services upon which procurement demand has not been issued and for which no written contract has been executed, in support of the Republic of Korea from 25 Jun 50 to date. Disposition of cases in which procurement demands have been issued is under advisement. By C/N 1, 22 Jul 50, JA forwarded to Compt for consideration a draft of a proposed contract under which reimbursement can be effected to the Japanese Government for services, supplies and facilities necessarily initially obtained by procurement demand or later requisitioned, but subsequently used for the Korean operation.

(Col Nuss and Mr. Osborn - Budget & Fiscal Div), advises CG Eighth Army that authority is granted to negotiate contracts confirming the procurement of supplies and services upon which procurement demand has not been issued and for which no written contract has been executed, in support of the Republic of Korea from 25 Jun 50 to date. Further, that each agency obtaining the supplies and services will furnish Eighth Army Procurement Section with complete statements of facts and pertinent papers deemed necessary by Eighth Army Procurement Section to support findings of fact required of a contracting officer. Cases in which procurement demands have been issued are not within the scope of this authority, and will be made the subject of separate correspondence emanating from this headquarters.

CINCPAC msg ZX 10007, 5 Jul 50, advised the DA that due to impracticability of operating Cash Clothing Allowance System in combat areas, replacement issues of personal clothing to enlisted personnel in Korea and repair thereof would be made gratuitously and where gratuitous issues and maintenance exist, the Cash Clothing Allowance System is being suspended. DA msg WCL 31390, 7 Jul 50, approved CINCPAC's action. CINCPAC msg ZX 10203, 7 Jul 50, to CG 8th Army and EUSAFIK advised that effective 1 Jul 50 the Cash Clothing Allowance System for Army enlisted personnel assigned to duty in Korea was suspended and that replacement issues of personal clothing and repair thereof would be made gratuitously.

2. DA msg W 86036, 15 Jul 50, grants authority to units in ZI who are under movement orders to FEC to suspend the Cash Clothing Allowance System. DA msg W 86037, 15 Jul 50, authorizes suspension of Cash Clothing Allowance System for individuals in units in combat areas and in units moving to combat areas.

3. Since the date of CINCPAC's msg ZX 10007, 5 Jul 50, advising the DA that the Cash Clothing Allowance System was being suspended for enlisted personnel assigned to duty in Korea, units had been ordered to FEC from the ZI and the DA has suspended the Cash Clothing Allowance System for individuals in these units. In order to provide uniformity, flexibility, and ease of movement of units to and from combat areas including replacements and evacuees CINCPAC msg C 58271, 20 Jul 50, advised DA that Cash Clothing Allowance System was being suspended in the FEC. To date, the DA has not indicated their approval or disapproval of CINCPAC's action in msg C 58271, 20 Jul 50.

4. At a conference conducted by G-4 Sup 0930, 26 Jul, with representatives from FEF and H.V.F.E., the FEF representative Col Williams, stated that AF ammo was in good sup except for 5-inch rockets. Col Williams and Maj Harpole, both of FEF stated that anything that CINCPAC could do to clarify sups enroute to FEF and EIA thereat would be helpful. b. FEF representatives stated the rate of rocket use was approx 1000 per day - an increase from 400 per day due to availability of additional aircraft. Weight of projectile makes air lift impracticable since only 80 rds can be lifted per C-54 plane, requiring 12 to 13 planes a day for this item alone to meet current expenditure replacement. Rockets have been obtained from Navy sources to meet current needs. A resupply will be required by 5 Aug as current expenditure rates.

1. Initial action on this project was initiated by CINCPAC msg CX 56829 June 27 to DA requesting consideration and comments on a freq shift plan for FEC longhaul radio circuits in event of disruptive intentional interference or jamming.

2. DA (SIGOL-1) reply W 84528 advised that complement of freqs have been cleared for use Tokyo-Ft. Shafter SSB/RTT in event interference or jamming and that assignment by FAP will follow. DA also advised that additional complements other inter-theater circuits and joint aspects of problem are under study.

3. DA PAF USJCEC interim reply msg 84608 dated 29 June assigned complement of freqs to Ft. Shafter, Honolulu-Tokyo SSB/RTT circuit for use in case of intentional disruptive interference. Further, DA requested notification whenever it became necessary to use above freqs. Also, whether AF inter-theater circuits should be included in freq shift planning. Freq shift complement referred to above folo:

Tokyo Transmitter - 9920, 11697.5, 18270, 20135

Ft. Shafter Transmitter - 9397.5, 12060, 17870, 20425

4. CO, 71st Sig Svc Bn was immediately advised by check sheet dated 28 June of the alternate freqs and requested to obtain nec crystals.

5. DA msg (SIGAP-1) W 84675 June 30 following up DA msg W 84608 made general recommendations with respect to anti-countermeasures plan and recommended establishment of fol circuits:

a. Tokyo-Adak low freq circuit.

b. Tokyo-Asmara RATT circuit.

6. CINCPAC msg CX 57046 dated 1 July 50 answering DA msg W 84675 concurred in establishment of above circuits, also, in the interim countermeasures freq shift plans. Part 5 of CINCPAC msg assigned the Tokyo-SF RATT freq complement to RYCOM for RYCOM to use as an alternate terminal in case Tokyo Terminal became inoperative.

7. DA msg W 85063 proposed freqs for Tokyo-Asmara circuit, Tokyo-Adak circuit and changed Part 5 of CINCPAC msg CX 57046 to read "Tokyo-SF RTT freqs assigned to RYCOM for RYCOM-SF SSB circuit as alternate terminal for Tokyo." This resulted in CINCPAC msg CX 57448 passing DA info to RYCOM and CINCPAC msg C 57587 passing the info to CG Sixth Army.

8. Msg AMSIG RB744 from Sixth Army to CINCPAC made counter proposal; however, due to the fact that Sixth Army not prepared with SSB receiver coils or crystals for the freqs concerned, Sixth Army proposed RTT rather than SSB RYCOM to SF (alternate for Tokyo Terminal).

9. CINCPAC msg CX 58061 referred the matter to DA for attention and necessary action.

10. DA msg W 86352 addressed to CINCPAC and Sixth Army with info to CINCAL and CINCPAC cancels DA proposal made in msg W 85053 and establishes fol: (to be activated by RYCOM in emergency if Tokyo Terminal becomes inoperative).

a. RYCOM-SF SSB using freqs from Honolulu-SF SSB which closes upon activation RYCOM-SSB.

b. RYCOM-SF RTT/MUX using freqs from Tokyo-SF RTT/MUX.

11. In view above change, a separate msg was originated to Sixth Army correcting CINCPAC msg C 57587.
