This msg in four parts. Subj is Sale of Scrap and Waste by the Eighth Army Exchange Service for Yen. CINCFFE msg CX 65067, 3 Nov 48 is rescinded. Effective immediately the following will apply to subj sales of scrap and waste.

Part I. In addition to the disposal authorization contained in ltr, GHQ FEC, subj: Disposal of Waste, 27 Feb 47, the Eighth Army Exchange Service is hereby authzd to dispose of salable scrap and waste materials accruing from its operation by sale to the Japanese Govt and/or other purchasers.

Part II. The present unexpended balance of yen held by the Eighth Army Exchange Service acquired through sales of scrap and waste, as well as future income from these and other authzd sales, may be expended to defray current operational expenses and such other obligations payable in indigenous currency, provided such yen expenditures are not otherwise prohibited by existing directives.

Part III. Regarding current directives governing acquisition of yen, paragraph 8c, Section I, Circular 19, GHQ FEC, 15 Mar 49, is being revised to include the following:

"8c. Quasi-official organizations previously authzd by the Commander-in-Chief, Far East, to acquire indigenous currency through the sale of scrap, waste, and other specifically authorized sales, and Chaplain's funds or religious funds which acquire indigenous currency through voluntary donations in connection with religious activities, may disburse indigenous currency so acquired to defray current operational expenses and to pay such other obligations as may be paid in indigenous currency, provided such yen expenditures are not otherwise prohibited by existing directives."

Part IV. The provisions of this msg apply to sales of scrap and waste materials by US commercial organizations operating as concessionaires of the Eighth Army Exchange Service.
