Subj: Chinese POW interrogation. Name: Tshu, Tsei, Chiang. Captured Unsan 28 Oct. Unit: 2d Bn, 56th Unit, Chinese Peace Preservation Army in Korea. The 1st, 2d, and 3d Bns are composed of part of pers from the 118th, 119th, and 120th Divs of the 40th Army. The 40th Army and 3 Divs remained at Antung while token forces from 40th Army Hq and from each of its Divs entered Korea on 20 Oct. Each Bn is composed of apprx 1000 men. Total str of 56 units is 5000. Prisoner observed 5000 men crossing with him over RR bridge from Antung to Sinuiju. Unit arrived Unsan 25 Oct. Observed no tks or arty. Low morale because of air atk. 56th Unit had 5 or 6 Korean interpreters. Unit carried 14 days supply corn and 2 days supply bread. PW was messenger. States no part of unit intergrated into Korean unit. No instructions to appear as vols. 2d Bn was to adv S instruction issued 28 Oct. PW further states he heard that a similar unit the 55th Unit composed from Divs of the 39th Army has also entered Korea. All info unconfirmed.

This radio will clarify source of food for prisoners of war in Korea and is in 4 parts.

Part 1. ROKA stocks will be fed to prisoners of war in enclosures at Pusan, Inchon and Pyongyang and to prisoners of war in hands of ROKA troops.

Part 2. ROKA stocks when available will be fed to prisoners of war in hands of UN troops. US stocks will be fed to prisoners of war only when ROKA or indigenous stocks are not available.

Part 3. Indigenous stocks may be either seized from North Korean Govt supplies or requisitioned from private agencies north of the 38th Parallel providing health of local populace is not impaired to feed prisoner of war while they are north of 38th Parallel.

Part 4. No stocks will be requisitioned or seized without approval of CG, Corps or Division.

REMYMSG GX 26350 KTR, GX 26415 KGLX and GX 26524 KGLX. Since dispatch of cited msgs enemy resistance to advance of Army Eight has progressively increased and consumption rates, principally of Class 5 are increasing accordingly. In addition, the tactical situation indicated necessity for employment of the 2d Inf Div to the north, thereby increasing the demand upon supplies air lifted to K 23 and K 29. Situation may also dictate employment of 25th Inf Div. Inasmuch as current airlift constitutes essentially entire logistic support for Army Eight troops north of Pyongyang, and is insufficient to support operations on the scale and of the nature indicated by recent developments it is urgently requested that every consideration be given to the following:

- A. Continuation of minimum airlift of 1000 tons per day.
- B. Opening of Port of Chinnampo continues as critical requirement.
- C. 2d Log Comd requires minimum of 19 LST's in addition to 6 Maru type vessels previously requested for support of current and imminent operations.

Following info from Wallar info in reply to inquiry from Diehl. Message in 13 parts corresponding numbered questions query from Diehl.

Part 1. Between 25 Oct and 5 Nov all Bank of Chosun notes in Kyonggido and Kangwondo, south of 38, must be deposited or exchanged for Bank of Korea notes. Between 5 and 12 Nov all Bank of Chosun notes in all provinces South Korea except those where conversion already carried out must be deposited or exchanged. Each household will receive certificate entitling persons residing therein 1 deposit or 1 exchange. If amount is less than two zero thousand won **payment may be made in cash**, otherwise all over two zero thousand won must be deposited and withdrawals are limited to five zero thousand won per household in any 1 month. All Bank of Chosun notes held by government (including ROK Army), government organizations, juridical persons, and associations must be deposited. Government and government organizations may withdraw all or part in Bank of Korea notes. Juridical persons and associations may withdraw only after Minister of Finance is satisfied as to source of funds and that the organization did not collaborate or cooperate with communists regime.

Part 2. Approximately 17 billion won of which 13 billion won was exchanged for cash and four billion was deposited.

Part 3. No. Governor, Bank of Korea reports United States printed currency undamaged and apparently untouched except for removal of hundred pieces of each denomination.

Part 4. By United Nations and ROK Forces: Bank of Korea notes, 101 thousand won; Bank of Chosun 100 won notes, 17 million won; 46 series printed after invasion, 10 million won; thousand

1. Ref Annex to General Order 2, 7 Oct 50, following report made for informational purposes.
2. Home Minister, ROK, in visit to C/O, Army Eight, on 23 Oct proposed in substance that:
 - A. ROK Govt be authorized to assist CG Army Eight in procurement and selection of suitable personnel for local and provincial govts of North Korea. Proposed personnel would come from among refugees from North Korea currently residing in South Korea.
 - B. Estimated 2 million refugees who fled from North Korea to South Korea about 2 years ago be allowed to return to North Korea.
3. Home minister offered ROK National Police for attachment to and opn under control of ml authority, in North Korea. He expressed concern that UN might lose political victory after winning ml victory, that Fed agencies and organizations may reestablish selves in North Korea, and that North Korea will suffer from lack of competent leaders and professional men if refugees not returned.
4. No comment was made to Home Ministers proposals, either in agreement or disagreement. US ambassador to Korea is aware of views of ROK Govt presented by Home Minister.

Part 1. Rqst boundary between Army Eight and X US Corps as prescribed in Para 1, cited reference be amended as follows:

Omit "39th Parallel from Japan Sea to---" and substitute "38th Parallel from Japan Sea to 128 degrees east thence northwest to Poptong-Ni 127 degrees 5 minutes east-38 degrees 58 minutes north thence north to 39 degree Parallel thence west on 39 degree Parallel to 126 degree 45 minutes east---."

Part 2. The recommended change above extends the present zone of X Corps to the south to include generally the area seized and cleared by the ROK I Corps in it's advance north of the 38th Parallel. With the atchmt of I ROK Corps to X US Corps, ROK Army's only means for assuming responsibility for this area is with the II ROK Corps now currently engaged in further adv to the north. The newly formed 11th ROK Div and the 5th ROK Div recently organized, are fully engaged in assisting in clearing remaining enemy elms south of the 38th Parallel. Present plans contemplate turning over this responsibility to ROK Army at an early date in order to free US troops for further offensive opns to the north. The proposed increase in the zone of responsibility of X Corps will permit freedom of mvmt nec for the protection of the vital Wonsan area against enemy forces infiltrating to the north.
